

# **The Song of the Lamb Discussion Questions**

Revelation 15:1-8

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1. Why does justice demand God's judgement and wrath?
2. What feelings or thoughts do you have about God's wrath? Why?
3. How do you feel about God's wrath ending with these final bowl judgments?
4. If God just overlooked evil, would that be justice? Why or why not?
5. How is God's justice satisfied by Jesus' death on the cross? How can this payment be applied to the Christian's life?
6. What happens to those who don't accept His payment? Does this satisfy God's judgment? Why or why not?
7. How can we experience God's peace and calmness in this chaotic world?
8. Read Exodus 15:1-18 and compare it to Revelation 15:3-4. How are these songs the same? What are they pointing out about God? What would you include in a song about what God has done for you?
9. What was the importance and significance of the temple in Jerusalem to the Jewish people? What is the significance of the heavenly temple? Why is it important that the heavenly temple is open?
10. Why do these bowl judgments come out of the heavenly temple? What does this mean?
11. What is the significance of these bowls being designed to be poured out quickly, easily, and completely?
12. Why couldn't anyone enter the temple until the seven bowl judgments were finished? Does this mean we will be able to enter the temple after the judgments are over? Why or why not?
13. How is God's sovereignty displayed by God's wrath?
14. How will God's wrath during the bowl judgments differ from what we have read about in God's word or possibly seen ourselves?
15. Have you gone through the door of salvation? If not, what prevents you from going through and accepting God's payment for your sins?
