

Opportunity Day Preschool FAO's

1. What days of the week is Opportunity Day Preschool in session?

Classes are scheduled on Monday, Wednesday and/or Friday of each week during the school year except for holidays that may fall on those given days. (*1-year- old class only meets on Monday and Wednesday*.) You can choose any combination of those days to register your child during the registration process.

2. What time is Opportunity Day Preschool in session?

Arrival time is 9 AM and dismissal is 2:30 pm each Monday, Wednesday and Friday that we are in session. The doors open each school day at 8:58 a.m. and 2:25 p.m.

3. What is the calendar schedule for Opportunity Day Preschool?

Opportunity Day operates on a similar schedule to the Speedway Public school system, with a few exceptions. A complete calendar, including holidays and breaks will be provided by the end of the 2022-2023 school year. Opportunity Day does not hold class in the summer.

4. How much does Opportunity Day cost?

\$100.00 per month, per child, for 1 day per week. \$190.00 per month, per child, for 2 days per week. \$255.00 per month, per child, is offered for 3 days per week.

5. How can I get an application for Opportunity Day?

You can get an application by going to Speedway Christian Church and receiving one from the Opportunity Day office or the church office. You can also print one out from our website at www.speedwaychristian.org.

6. When is tuition due?

Fees are due the 1st class day of each month beginning in September and ending in May. **NO TUITION FEE IS DUE IN AUGUST.**

7. Is there a registration fee?

A separate non-refundable registration fee of \$40 per application is due at the time the enrollment application is submitted. If more than one child (from the same household) is enrolled, the registration fee will be reduced to \$30 for each additional sibling enrolled. (For example, if you are registering two children, your total registration fee will be \$70.00)

8. Is there a registration fee even if my child is on the waiting list?

Yes, the same non-refundable, \$40 registration fee applies to the waiting list registration.

9. Am I guaranteed that my child will be registered for the days I selected?

Returning children will have first choice in class scheduling (provided the child's application and all required materials are submitted on-time). Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served bases. Every effort is made to register your child for the day/s you have selected. If we are unable to register your child for your preferred choices, you will be contacted within 2 weeks.

10. How old does my child need to be to register for Opportunity Day?

Opportunity Day is a preschool program designed especially for children from 1 year of age through 5 years of age.

1's Class (Must be 1 on or before 8.1.23) 2's Class (Must be 2 on or before 8.1.23) 3's Class (Must be 3 on or before 8.1.23) 4's Class (Must be 4 on or before 8.1.23)

11. What do I need to do to register my child for Opportunity Day?

To complete the process for your child's enrollment, the following items are required with **each** submitted application. Failure to submit the following materials could result in your child not being registered.

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Completed health form
- 3. Current copy of child's immunization record (new copy required each year)
- 4. Copy of child's birth certificate (new students only)
- 5. Non-refundable registration fee (Checks payable to Speedway Christian Church)

12. Can my child be placed on the waiting list for future years to come?

No. Our waiting list is just for children that are currently eligible for Opportunity Day. They can only be placed on the waiting list for the class they are currently eligible to attend.

13. Does my child need to be potty-trained before attending Opportunity Day?

No. The children in the 1's and 2's classes do not need to be potty trained before attending Opportunity Day. It is strongly encouraged that the children in the 3's class be potty-trained or working on it at the time school starts. We are happy to support what you are doing at home to ensure a positive and successful potty-training experience

14. Do I get a refund if my child misses' school because they are sick?

No, there are no refunds for non-attendance.

15. What is the day like for my preschooler?

Activities for each class include crafts, music, playtime, etc. Classes for the older children will provide more academics in preparation for Kindergarten. Children will bring their own lunch each day. A midmorning snack will be provided by Opportunity Day or occasionally may be brought in by parent volunteers. The classes have a structured agenda that is appropriate to their class age. At the end of the day, classes will have "quiet time", designed for the children to rest after a busy day. Younger children tend to sleep during this time. Older children tend not to, but they are expected to lie quietly and rest.
