LIBRARY MATERIALS AND TEXTBOOK REMINDERS

All library materials must be returned as soon as possible so that inventory of our library materials can be completed prior to the last day.

Students in grades 6-12 will receive a printed notice of textbooks that are checked out to them in the coming days. Please go over the list with your son or daughter to ensure they are in possession of their textbooks.

Textbooks will be collected by classroom teachers in grades K - 8 near the end of the school year. Students in grades 9-12 will turn in books to their teacher(s) when they take their final exams.

From the handbook: *Students are expected to be good stewards of all CCA property, including text and workbooks. Students in every grade will be responsible for maintaining good condition of all textbooks and workbooks. Families will be billed for lost or damaged textbooks. "Damage" is determined by the textbook committee and is defined as "more than normal wear." At the close of the academic year, families who have not paid for lost or damaged materials will not have access to FACTS and school records will be held until outstanding invoices are settled.*

REPORT CARDS

Grades will be posted on Friday, May 30th. All outstanding balances must be paid in order for families to have access to student grade reports. Please note the office will be closed on Thursday, May 29th and Friday, May 30th. If you are unable to access your FACTS account once grades are posted, please contact the office on or after Monday, June 2nd.
