Students in every grade will be responsible for maintaining good condition of all textbooks and workbooks. Families will be billed for lost or damaged textbooks. "Damage" is determined by the textbook committee and is defined as "more than normal wear." At the close of the academic year, families who have not paid for lost or damaged materials will not have access to FACTS and school records will be held until outstanding invoices are settled.
