Lieutenant Colonel Jonathan D. Metcalf is a Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives (FACHE) and currently serves as the Deputy Commander for Administration (Chief Operating Officer) at Winn Army Community Hospital in Fort Stewart, GA, a 50-bed community hospital supporting over 45,000 enrolled beneficiaries with an annual budget of \$160M.

A combat-proven healthcare leader with over 18 years of experience in the U.S. Army, Jonathan has a distinguished track record of driving operational excellence and strategic growth in complex healthcare environments. His recent accomplishments include implementing programs that increased patient enrollment by 10,000 beneficiaries over nine months, increasing access to primary and care by 300%, and leading the successful consolidation of outpatient specialty services between the Department of War's only Level I Trauma Center and an ambulatory surgical center.

Prior to his current role, Jonathan held several executive positions, including Vice President of Business Operations and Deputy Chief of Staff at Brooke Army Medical Center. His experience also extends to operational and contingency planning as a Healthcare Operations and Medical Evacuation Planner for the XVIII Airborne Corps and as a MEDEVAC Company Commander with the 82nd Airborne Division, where he was directly responsible for a fleet of 15 helicopters and over 100 personnel.

Jonathan holds a Master of Health Administration and a Master of Business Administration from Baylor University. He also earned a Bachelor of Science from the United States Military Academy at West Point and holds ratings in the UH-60A/L/M and LUH-72A helicopters as an Army Aviator.
