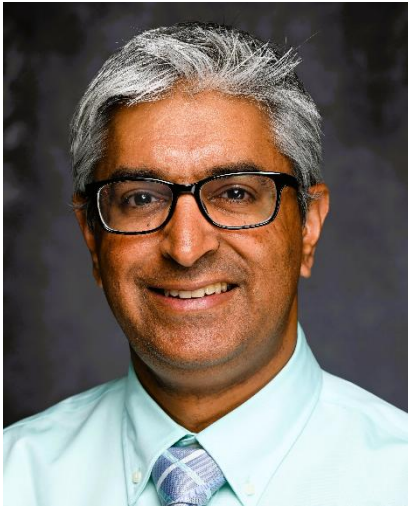




**Mehul Tejani, MD, MPH,
