Angela’s nursing experience was an asset to her as she led a successful turnaround effort at CMH, which was close to shutting down. Angela implemented a business strategy based on working with other South Georgia hospitals. CMH has also grown other revenues, successfully recruiting a physician to rural South Georgia and launching a Family Practice. Angela’s success gained national news coverage as she was featured in the November 2020 Edition of *TIME Magazine*. Angela was also named Hospital Leader of the Year by *HomeTown Health* in 2018 and CMH was recognized by *HomeTown Health* as Hospital of the Year for 2019.
