




How to use the sample .csv file in Excel and retain leading zeros:


Open the Sample .csv File in Excel




Click on the left corner of the excel spreadsheet (highlighted in yellow below)



Once the all the cells are highlighted, go up to the drop-down arrow where it says 'General':



From the drop-down, change it from 'General' to 'Text':



Now you can begin to enter your precode information, and the leading zeros will be retained in the column.
