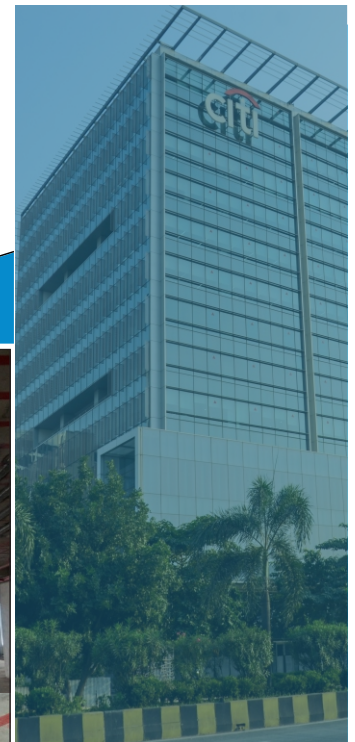

Structure Details

The First International Financial Centre (FIFC) is a 14-story office building within Mumbai's Bandra Kurla Complex, a hub of multinational corporate offices in a new central business district established by the government near the city's International Airport. This is a LEED certified Gold Rated building Housing many high profile Multinationals as tenants.

Brief Scope of work:

SSPI installed **400 RM of Carbon Laminates (100x1.4 mm) on the floor of 5th slab** at the locations spanning the Pour Strip and 900 RM(100 x 1.4 mm) of Carbon Laminates on the soffit of 5th slab spanning Pour Strip. Also at the column Capital location, on the 5th floor **Carbon Wraps of 230gsm** were applied.

Project Highlights

- FIFC is an important building in the heart of business centre in Mumbai. The offices here are owned by top multi-nationals, global organizations.
- The work was scheduled to be carried out in monsoon, whereas the process for strengthening required control of moisture content.
- SSPI has tackled the project with meticulous planning and has successfully executed the job within time and quality.
