HOSPICE CARE LEVELS

Hospice focuses on terminally ill patients' pain and symptoms while keeping them as comfortable as possible. It is available to patients with less than six months to live. There are four distinct levels of hospice care: Routine home care is the basic level, which may consist of nursing care and therapy. The second level is continuous home care, in which care is needed for at least eight hours per day. General inpatient care is the third level where patients may require treatment at an inpatient facility for the short-term. Respite care, the fourth level, is more about the family than the patient. If a family member is having a difficult time, a temporary inpatient environment can be provided.
