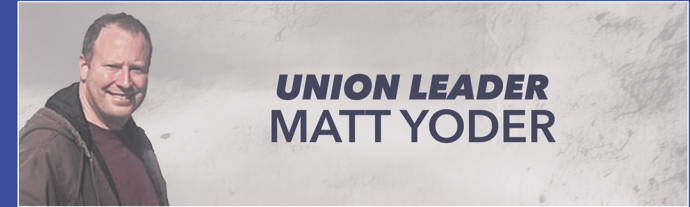

**PARTY AFFILIATION**

**LIFELONG REPUBLICAN**

*Maintains a solidly conservative voting record in the PA House<sup>7</sup>  
A founding member of the PA House Freedom Caucus<sup>8</sup>  
Prior to being elected in 2022, helped elect Republicans in Columbia County<sup>1</sup>*

**LIFELONG DEMOCRAT**

*until a few weeks ago when he switched parties to run<sup>1</sup>  
He's a leader in a union that supports Democrats, including Biden, Fetterman, & Casey<sup>2,3,4</sup>  
Just last year, ran as a Democrat for District Judge and lost<sup>1</sup>*

**OPPOSES TAX INCREASES**

**YES**

*Has NEVER voted to raise taxes<sup>7</sup>  
Co-Sponsored the Taxpayer Protection Act (HB786), a bill that makes it much harder to raise taxes<sup>7</sup>  
Co-Sponsored HB100, a bill that provides property tax relief for seniors<sup>7</sup>*

**NO**

*As a Benton school director, voted 4 times in 4 years to raise property taxes<sup>9</sup>  
Voted to increase Benton Area school taxes by 18%<sup>9</sup>  
The Press Enterprise labeled Yoder's vote as the "maximum property tax hike" allowed by law<sup>1</sup>*

**BELIEVES THE U.S. SHOULD DO MORE TO PHYSICALLY SECURE THE BORDER**

*Co-Sponsored HB1840, a bill that would ban sanctuary cities in PA<sup>7</sup>  
Co-Sponsored HB1890, a bill that would ban non-citizens from voting in PA elections<sup>7</sup>*

*He's a leader in a union that supports Biden's Open Border Policy<sup>2</sup>*

**SUPPORTS 2ND AMENDMENT GUN RIGHTS**

**REFUSED TO ANSWER<sup>5,6</sup>**

*He's a leader in a union that opposes school choice & efforts to increase parental involvement in public schools<sup>2</sup>*

**SUPPORTS THE RIGHT TO LIFE**

**YES<sup>5,6</sup>**

*Endorsed by PA Pro-Life Federation<sup>8</sup>  
Co-Sponsored the Pro-Life Heartbeat Bill (HB820)<sup>7</sup>*

**REFUSED TO ANSWER<sup>5,6</sup>**

*He's a leader in a union that opposes the right to life<sup>2</sup>*

**SUPPORTS PROHIBITING PUBLIC SCHOOLS FROM ALLOWING MALES WHO IDENTIFY AS FEMALES TO COMPETE IN GIRLS' SPORTS**

**YES<sup>6</sup>**

*Voted against HB300, a bill that would have allowed men & boys to compete in girls' high school sports<sup>7</sup>*

**REFUSED TO ANSWER<sup>5</sup>**

*He's a leader in a union that advocates for allowing boys who identify as girls to compete in girls' high school sports<sup>2</sup>*
