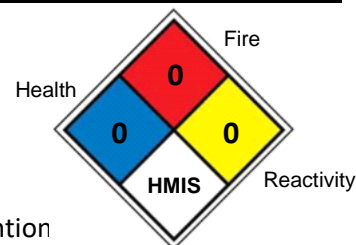

**3 COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS**

**Composition / Formula:** Contains: Potassium Phosphate, monobasic (CAS 7778-77-0), Sodium Phosphate, dibasic (CAS 7558-79-4), Potassium Chloride (CAS 7447-40-7), and Sodium Chloride (CAS 7647-14-5) in water.

**4 FIRST AID MEASURES**

**Inhalation:** Move to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, provide oxygen. Seek medical attention if needed.  
**Skin Contact:** If skin irritation occurs, wash with soap and water.  
**Eye Contact:** Immediately flush eyes with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes, lifting eyelids occasionally to facilitate irrigation.  
**Ingestion:** Rinse mouth with water. Consult a physician if needed.

**5 FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES**

**Fire Fighting:** Not expected to ignite. If involved in a fire, use appropriate extinguishing agent for surrounding fire.  
**Specific Fire Hazards:** Decomposes on heating emitting oxides of carbon.

**6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES**

**Accidental Release:** Wear suitable laboratory protective clothing. Pick up excess with inert absorbant material and place into separate waste container. Flush area with warm soapy water.
