




YOUR JOURNEY BEGINS...

ZÜRICH, SWITZERLAND

FEBRUARY 27 Arrive in Zürich on your independent flight and meet fellow travelers and your expedition staff for a welcome dinner at the **Dolder Grand**, which boasts a panoramic view of the city, Lake Zürich and the Alps. We depart for **Ethiopia** the following day.

ADDIS ABABA, ETHIOPIA

From sacred Mount Entoto to the holy city of Lalibela, Ethiopia is an essential site of pilgrimage for any traveler, containing archaeological treasures from some of the earliest humans.



FEBRUARY 28 - MARCH 1 Fly to Ethiopia, nestled in the Horn of Africa, which juts into the Arabian Sea. We land in the capital of Addis Ababa, an intriguing blend of ancient and modern set in the foothills of the majestic Entoto Mountains. Explore the city, home to the culturally intriguing Ethnological Museum and the ornate Holy Trinity Cathedral, which commemorates the country's liberation from Italian occupation. Visit the Muya Ethiopia gallery, where master artisans create textiles, pottery and accessories using traditional Ethiopian patterns and techniques.

Or choose to take a charter flight to the holy city of **Lalibela**, a UNESCO World Heritage site, to see the monolithic rock-hewn churches, including the **Church of St. George**, the most well-

known of the area's 11 churches. Carved from solid red volcanic rock, the churches' construction is attributed to King Lalibela, who set out to build a "New Jerusalem" during the 12th century. Wander the cool, candlelit interiors and richly decorated grottoes, and watch as priests go about their daily rituals at this major center of pilgrimage.

ACCOMMODATIONS In the center of Addis Ababa, the **Sheraton Addis** is located on a hilltop overlooking the city and features well-appointed rooms with private balconies and personal service.

ADDIS ABABA, ETHIOPIA MAHÉ, SEYCHELLES: 3H 20M

SEYCHELLES

Witness the incredible biodiversity of the Seychelles, an immaculately preserved island paradise set in the azure waters of the Indian Ocean.



MARCH 2 - 4 With its idyllic waters, unspoiled beaches and plentiful sailboats, the Seychelles could have been taken directly from the pages of your favorite travel magazine. Of the 115-island archipelago, 50 percent of its land is protected, resulting in an exceptional ecosystem. Nicknamed "The Galápagos of the Indian Ocean," the islands serve as sanctuary to a spectacular array of wildlife, from giant Aldabra tortoises to tropicbirds. Island culture is a colorful mix of Asian, African and European heritages, creating multi-ethnic customs that will leave an unforgettable impression.

Snorkel in seas filled with marine life and get a taste of local flavors at a colorful covered market and during a Creolethemed gala dinner. Spot rare and native orchids among diverse flora during a visit to the **National Botanical Gardens**. Learn about conservation efforts to protect the island's

pristine beauty and thriving ecosystems at the Natural History Museum. Take a guided tour through the Vallée de Mai Nature Reserve on Praslin, home to the coco de mer palms found only on the island. Or travel by boat to La Digue, a biologically diverse island overflowing with coconut palms, hibiscus gardens and vanilla vines.

ACCOMMODATIONS With its exquisite Creole-style pool villas along the Indian Ocean, **Banyan Tree Seychelles** is a tropical haven. Stand on the expansive veranda to take in the swaying Takamaka trees or soak up the sun while relaxing in the infinity pool.

SERENGETI PLAIN OR NGORONGORO CRATER, TANZANIA

One of the world's greatest wildlife destinations, Tanzania is home to the legendary big five: lions, leopards, cape buffaloes, elephants and rhinos.







MARCH 5 - 6 Embark on a safari adventure in the Serengeti, Tanzania's largest national park and sanctuary to diverse fauna, including 500 species of birds. Set off on game drives across the seemingly unending landscape, which serves as the backdrop to one of the most ancient migration rituals on Earth.

Throughout the year, more than **one million wildebeest**, accompanied by **gazelles** and **zebras**, make a circuitous, perilous trek across the Serengeti, seeking out fresh grazing and water. Along the way, they encounter **lions**, **leopards**, **crocodiles** and other carnivores always on the hunt, resulting in a primal spectacle unlike any other. Because this cycle is continuous, the Serengeti is always teeming with a **dizzying array of wildlife**.

Alternate: If you'd like to see a different side of Tanzania, opt to visit the **Ngorongoro Crater**, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the largest unbroken caldera in the world. Observe

its permanent population of about 25,000 animals, including critically endangered black rhinos.

ACCOMMODATIONS Deep within Africa's finest game reserve, **Four Seasons Safari Lodge Serengeti** delivers an unparalleled luxury safari experience. You might even spot elephants at the local watering hole as you float blissfully in the infinity pool. Enjoy a rejuvenating spa and stylish, comfortable guest rooms.

Alternate: On the edge of the caldera, the andBeyond Ngorongoro Crater Lodge is the perfect base for crater exploration. Guest rooms immerse you in colonial-style luxury and your private viewing deck offers panoramic views of the crater.


MARCH 7 - 9 Surrounded by wild Atlantic surf and world-renowned vineyards, Cape Town is a stylish outpost at the edge of the Earth. The city's most beloved landmark is the majestic Table Mountain, a flat-topped mountain that soars two-thirds of a mile above sea level. Ride a cable car to the summit and stroll along a wooden walkway to see striking panoramic views of the city and the sea. Keep an eye out for the diminutive rock hyrax, a rodent-like creature that is the closest living relative of the modern-day elephant and manatee.

Visit the Cape of Good Hope, taking in the soaring cliffs and dramatic coastal views on your way to the end of the continent. Get up close and personal with the convivial African penguin colony among the coves of Boulders Beach. Or board a private boat for Robben Island, a UNESCO World Heritage site, where Nelson Mandela and other political

leaders were imprisoned. Enjoy some time to stroll around the **Victoria & Alfred Waterfront** with its collection of fine restaurants, friendly pubs and international boutiques. Journey into the **Cape Winelands**, meeting local winemakers and tasting award-winning regional vintages.

ACCOMMODATIONS One & Only Cape Town offers exquisite interior spaces, adorned with fabrics and furnishings recalling the warm, muted tones of Africa's savannahs. Resort features include a wine loft with a collection of more than 5,000 bottles, a spa on a private island and a heated infinity pool.

CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA 🗡 WALVIS BAY, NAMIBIA: 1H 50M

WALVIS BAY, NAMIBIA

 $Soar\ over\ Namibia's\ extraordinary\ natural\ landscapes, from\ cresting\ sand\ dunes\ to\ the\ sun-bleached\ spoils\ of\ the\ infamous\ Skeleton\ Coast.$







MARCH 10 - 11 Arguably the world's oldest desert, the Namib Desert has existed for about 43 million years. Its stunning landscapes are in constant flux with sand dunes and plains of all sizes and shapes stretching along its coast. As a testament to the importance of this starkly beautiful environment, Namibia is the first African country with an environmental conservation clause in its constitution.

Set on the Atlantic coast, **Swakopmund** is a former German colony and now Namibia's most popular holiday destination. A haven for nature lovers, **Walvis Bay** offers several outdoor options. Spot playful seals on a cruise, or spy rare pelicans and flamingos in the natural lagoon. On guided drives and walks explore the desert wildlife.

Go flightseeing over the Namib Desert for an eagle's-eye view of the colossal red dunes, some of the world's highest. Peer down at the haunting **Skeleton Coast**, where the turbulent Atlantic surf has tossed countless ships up on the wind-swept shoreline stretching north from Walvis Bay. Uncover the story of Namibia's maritime past, told through parched whale bones and deserted shipwrecks romantically shrouded in sea mist.

ACCOMMODATIONS Located between the Namib Desert and the Atlantic Ocean, **Strand Hotel Swakopmund** is the ideal base for your explorations of the Skeleton Coast. Designed to complement the historic train station that forms part of its grounds, the hotel has maintained its original design and also offers such amenities as a tranquil swimming pool surrounded by palm trees.


MARCH 12 - 14 The Okavango Delta is a wetland oasis—a wild maze of floodplains, narrow waterways and lagoons—and offers a completely different experience than the vast, dry vistas common on most East African safaris. Set out on a water safari, cruising at the gentle pace of a poled *mokoro*, a dugout canoe. The Okavango Delta is home to a staggering diversity of wildlife, including more than 400 bird species. Keep your eyes open for lions and cheetahs, as well as crocodiles and the red lechwe, an antelope that thrives in marshlands.

On early-morning and late-afternoon game drives, search for **leopards**, **spotted hyenas**, **hippos** and great herds of **buffalo**. Photograph beautiful big game including white rhino, herds of giraffe and elephants. Return to camp each evening for a classic sundowner, taking in the grand views with refreshments in hand.

ACCOMMODATIONS In Botswana, we split among the following camps: Under large, shady trees overlooking a floodplain filled with wildlife, Mombo Camp offers spacious en suite tented rooms on elevated wooden decks, each with its own plunge pool. Expansive verandas feature beautiful views of the northern tip of Chief's Island and the native wildlife.

Vumbura Plains Camp features large, luxurious tents with en-suite bathrooms and views of the sprawling floodplains. Set beneath a cool forest canopy of wild palms and gnarled fig trees, Sandibe Okavango Safari Lodge coexists peacefully with the magnificent landscape of southern Africa. Each guest suite looks out over the golden marshes, lush palm islands and shimmering waters of the Delta.



Survey the splendor of Victoria Falls, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World.




MARCH 15 Zambia is one of the most water-rich countries in Africa with its many rivers cascading into fabulous displays. See the awe-inspiring Victoria Falls, a UNESCO World Heritage site named by Scottish explorer Dr. David Livingstone for his queen. The Zambezi River measures more than a mile across where it plummets 354 feet over the edge of a basalt plateau. Called the "smoke that thunders" by the Kololo tribe, these spectacular falls plunge thunderously down a series of gorges and create a rainbow mist that can be seen from more than 12 miles away.

For our last meal together as a group, gather with fellow guests and expedition staff on the lawn of the Royal Livingstone Hotel to enjoy a festive farewell dinner.

ACCOMMODATIONS On the banks of the Zambezi River, the **Royal Livingstone Hotel** reflects the vibrant energy of its natural setting. The room décor is inspired by a blend of Victorian elegance and African hospitality. Hotel amenities include a pool, spa and gym.


LIVINGSTONE, ZAMBIA 🗡 KIGALI, RWANDA: 2H 30M

VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK OR KIGALI, RWANDA

Come face-to-face with the majestic mountain gorillas of Volcanoes National Park or explore Kigali, the cultural heart of the magnificent country.







MARCH 16 - 17 Land in Kigali and depart directly for two nights in the verdant mountains of Volcanoes National Park, where Dian Fossey famously studied mountain gorillas in their natural habitat. Accompanied by an expert naturalist guide, hike through beautiful bamboo forests to get up close with a family of gorillas. Mountain gorillas live in groups of up to 30 individuals led by an alpha male, known as a silverback for the gray streak of hair that stands out on his black coat. Spend an hour watching these peaceful giants munch leaves, groom each other and play.

Alternate: Opt to spend two nights in Kigali instead of gorilla trekking in the mountains. Get a feel for the growing city's cosmopolitan culture amid its wide tree-lined boulevards and lively markets. At Kigali Memorial Center, learn about the 1994 genocide through the survivors' stories, as well as how Rwandans are creating an environment for unity and healing. Visit the Akilah Institute, an inspiring vocational training program for young women. Choose to take a helicopter ride over the Virunga Mountains, a lush volcanic landscape dotted with picturesque lakes.

ACCOMMODATIONS Stay at one of the following properties. The guest cottages and main building of the Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge offer spectacular views of the volcanoes and countryside. Overlooking the Virunga volcanoes and shimmering lakes, the Virunga Lodge offers comfortable bandas (bungalows) with luxurious, en suite bathrooms. With views of the Virunga volcanoes, a pool and lush, well-tended grounds, the Five Volcanoes Boutique Hotel is a perfect place for relaxing after visiting the park. The newly constructed Amakoro Songa Lodge, a sustainable luxury nature resort, uses the latest energy efficient techniques and operates with a focus on conservation.

Alternate: Located on one of the city's most charming boulevards, the new Kigali Marriott Hotel provides contemporary accommodations and amenities, including a swimming pool, relaxing spa, well-equipped fitness center and multiple restaurants.

The acceptance of your Reservation Form and deposit by TCS creates a contractual relationship between you, the passenger/participant (Participant), in the Tour provided by TCS

Expedition Price: The Tour price of \$108,950 per person (double occupancy) with a \$10,895 single supplement includes a privately chartered Boeing 757 that departs from Zürich, Switzerland and returns to 7 ürich, Switzerland

Reservations and Payments: To reserve your place on the Tour, complete and sign the Reservation Form and return it with your deposit of \$10,000 per person.
