

Study Room Guidelines

The Library has two study rooms available for non-commercial public use. Wi-Fi is available.

Study Room 1 has one table, 6 chairs, and a whiteboard. It can accommodate up to 6 people. Ask for dry-erase markers and an eraser at the Circulation Desk.

Study Room 2 has 2 small tables and 2 chairs. It can accommodate up to 2 people.

The rooms shall not be used for commercial purposes or profit activities.

To book a study room online, a library card is required. The study rooms may also be booked in person or by phone.

Each booking may be from 30 minutes to 3 hours in length. The room may be booked up to 3 times per week (Sunday – Saturday) for up to nine hours per week for both rooms combined. Bookings may be made up to 1 month in advance.

Use by two or more people constitutes a use that day for each person present.

Patrons must notify the library if they will be arriving more than 15 minutes after their scheduled time. After 15 minutes, the library reserves the right to book it for another patron.

No food is allowed in the study rooms. You may bring a beverage in a covered container.

The patron is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and leaving the room in good condition. Patron is responsible for any damages occurring during their use.
