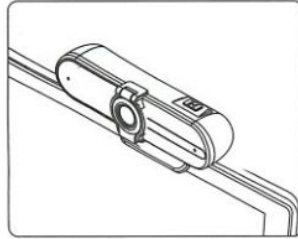
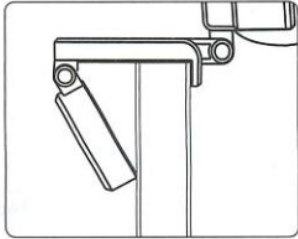
Product Diagram



Web Cam - Getting Started

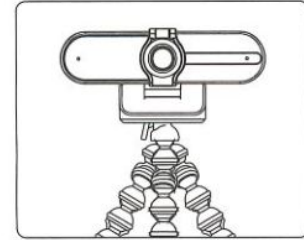
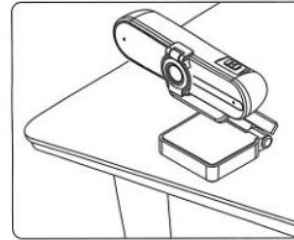
Getting Started Positioning the Webcam

On a flat-screen computer monitor or laptop screen: Rest the open clip on top edge of screen with lower part folded so it contacts back of screen and holds webcam in correct position. Tilt camera for best camera viewing angle.



On a desk or other flat surface: Adjust the stand and tilt camera for best camera viewing angle. For greater stability, angle the stand slightly forward and tilt camera back.

On a tripod: Attach webcam to a standard tripod mount with 1/4"20 screw thread. Tilt camera or adjust tripod for best camera viewing angle.

Boundary Mic - Windows Instructions

WINDOWS 7/8/10 INSTALLATION FOR USB MIC

- Step 1: Plug the USB port of the microphone directly into your laptop or desktop computer.
- Step 2: Right-click the Audio Manager icon on the lower right of the desktop, then click the recording devices.
- Step 3: You can see the microphone is set up and is on default, double click on microphone, then you can find Microphone properties.
- Step 4: Come to Listen, check listen to this device, then click the OK button (If you need to monitor when recording, click OK to save the settings).
- Step 5: Now, click on OK to save the settings.



Boundary Mic - Mac/Apple Instructions

Mac OS FOR USB MICROPHONE

Step 1: Click the desktop menu, then click **system preferences** ...

Step 2: Find sound button and click it.

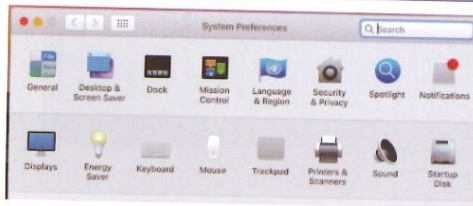
Step 3: Choose input you will find internal Microphone, turn off the input volume.

Step 4: Choose USB MIC **USB PnP Sound Device** Sound Device, adjust input volume. (General adjustment in the middle).

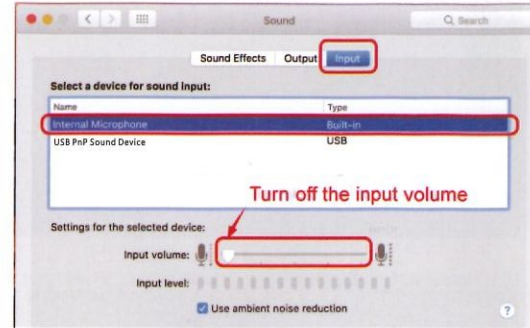
Step 5 : Test the microphone sound: search the built-in software: Quick Time Player.

Step 6 : Right click and select 'NEW Audio Recording'

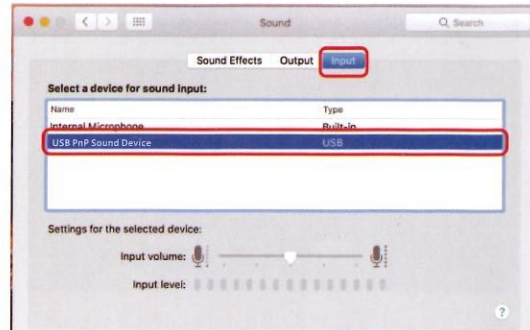
Step 7: After selecting the external USB microphone, click the recording button and you can record it.

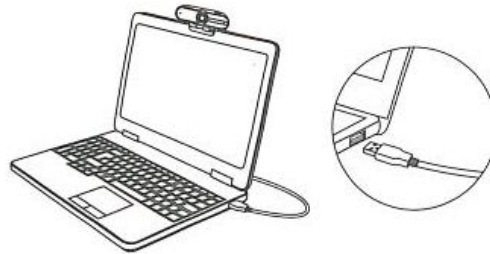

Web Cam - Connecting

Connecting and Using the Webcam

1. Connect the webcam USB cable to the computer USB port, and the LED indicators will light up red (the camera will then appear in the 'Devices and Printers' section of the 'Control Panel')
2. Open the video chat or recording software you want to use and begin a video call or video recording. While the camera is active, the LED indicators will be green
3. Adjust the clip/stand or pivot the camera to fine-tune the angle and view



Pause Button

Press the pause button when the camera is recording a video to pause/resume the video recording.
