Peter Mastroianni is Treasurer of The Airlift Tanker Association and is responsible for the financial affairs of the Association. His duties include preparing and maintaining financial records, maintaining and managing Association accounts in financial institutions, filing the annual Federal Income Tax return and contracting for the annual audit of A/TA financial records. The Treasurer is also Chairman of the Financial Committee which provides financial guidance for the Association. He became treasurer in January of 2019.

Peter is currently the Military Relations Liaison for Million Air. He is responsible for creating and fostering relationships with US Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corp and Coast Guard units nationwide, ensuring all Million Air locations exceed expectations when it comes to supporting the military warfighter. He has also been the General Manager for Million Air locations in Fayetteville AR and Gulfport-Biloxi MS.

Peter was commissioned in 1989 through the AFROTC program at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University (Daytona Beach). He attended Undergraduate Navigator Training at Mather AFB CA and received his wings in 1990. His first assignment was the KC-135R at Grissom AFB IN followed by assignments at RAF Mildenhall, Randolph AFB, McGuire AFB, Scott AFB, and Ramstein AB. He has served as an instructor navigator, Contingency Response Element Instructor/Evaluator, Deputy Chief, AMC Mobile Command and Control Operations Branch, Chief, Tanker Airlift Control Element Operations (Mobile Airfield Operations), AMC TALO/AMLO Functional Manager, USAFE KC-135 Functional Manager and Chief, USAFE Mobility and Airlift Training and Operations. His last assignment in the Air Force was as Chief, Standardization and Evaluation, 621 Contingency Response Wing, where he validated mission readiness, ensuring 800+ personnel and 42 AFSCs were trained & operated to published standards, assessed/proposed improvements to CRW processes/programs, and oversaw Quality Assurance, Air Trans Stan/Eval, Exercise Evaluation Team, Stan/Eval Board, & Staff Assistance Visit programs. He also advised CCs on Unit Type Code, Mission Essential Task List, & training course development and standardized operational procedures, and evaluated & trained all elements of Joint Task Force-Port Opening, Air Base Opening and global mobility missions. He retired from the Air Force as a major in October 2011.

Peter was born in Framingham, MA. He has a Bachelor of Science in Aeronautical Studies/Computer Science as well as a Masters in Aviation/Aerospace Operations and Management from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. Peter and his wife Bernadette reside in Gulfport MS. They have one grown Son, Mark.
