The Case for Change




Strategic Environment

- 4+1 challenges to U.S. and Allied interests
- "Gray Zone" challenges vs. "6-phase" model
 - China in S. China Sea / Russia in Crimea
- Multi-domain, non-linear, multiple COCOMs

Current Logistics Enterprise

- Theater and region focused
- No Common Operating Picture for Logistics
- No ability to C2 Logistics across entire enterprise





"The Air Force of 2035 must mature its ability to act quickly in response to dynamic adversaries within the changing future environment." – AF Future Operating Concept (Sep 15)




Current State: Theater-centric Focus



U.S. AIR FORCE

- Reactive
- No CommonOperating Picture
- Many lines of authority
- Manual, ad-hoc coordination
- Inefficient global asset utilization
- Requirement de-confliction may delay response time to Warfighter



Improving Decision Cycle Times






- We have invested in ISR and combat capabilities to shorten the kill-chain and improve decision cycle times






The Future Environment
