**Definition:**

**Physically active:** Participated in any physical activity/exercises other than regular job in last month.

**Food insecurity:** Participants couldn't afford balanced meals or food didn't last long & no money to get more.

**Housing Insecurity:** Participants were not able to pay their mortgage, rent of utility bills in last 12 months.

**Unsafe neighborhood:** Participants who responded their neighborhood to be unsafe/very unsafe by crime.

**Healthcare Access Hardship:** Participants who were not able to see a doctor due to cost in last 12 months.
