Our Visitor Philosophy

Akilah welcomes individuals, groups, and organizations from around the globe to visit our campus and to experience our vibrant Akilah community. Akilah's Executive Director, faculty, and staff introduce visitors to our model through classroom visits, intimate discussions with students, and a campus tour. We invest time and resources in these important visits and ask that visitors participate in offsetting the associated costs by choosing one of the following campus visitor options:

Option 1: Campus Tour

All visits include a comprehensive tour of our campus that details the history, education model, and culture of Akilah. Highlights include a presentation about our programs, our theory of change, and the impact of Akilah. Visitors are able to experience a glimpse of daily life at Akilah.

Option 2: Full Akilah Experience

The Akilah Experience is an expanded version of our Campus Tour that includes a private welcome with our Executive Director and tea/coffee with students. Visitors participate in a more in-depth and intimate discussion, and spend time getting to know our students, learning about the positive change that transpires during their Akilah journey. Depending on your interests and goals, additional briefings (schedule permitting) with Akilah's staff and or/faculty can be arranged. We can also offer snacks or a meal according to your preferences and dietary restrictions.

Time Commitment: 2 hours depending on custom briefings

Campus is located at KN 77 Avenue Kiyovu, Kigali, Rwanda. Turn left out of the entrance from the Marriott Hotel (KN 3 Avenue). Continue past the Serena Hotel and take a right at the end of the road when you see Kigali Conference and Exhibition Village. Continue down the street and just before the road starts to curve to the right, KN77 Avenue is on your left hand side. It's a small dirt road and our campus is the big red and grey building on the right. You will see our big signpost that reads: Akilah Institute.
