THE PROMISE OF ETERNAL LIFE TO GOD'S ELECT

Text:

Titus 1:1-4:

- ¹ Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the Faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;
- ² In hope of Eternal Life, which God, Who cannot lie, promised before the world began;
- ³ But hath in due times manifested His Word through preaching, which is committed unto me according to the Commandment of God our Saviour;
- ⁴ To Titus, mine own son after the common Faith: Grace, mercy, and Peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour.

1 John 1:9: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Introduction:

God's "ALL" means ALL. The atonement provided by Christ at Calvary's Cross

makes provision for us to be made as white as snow (to the Northerners) and as white as wool (to the Southerners) according to:

Isaiah 1:18: "Come now, and let us reason together," saith the LORD: "though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool."



Though your sins be as scarlet (which is a fast color and



refuses to come out of cloth, even with the strongest bleach and detergent), they shall be as white as snow; though they be red (another fast color which defies removal like crimson), they shall be as wool.

Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow.

Bible Proofs and Confirmations of this fact that Jesus' Blood cleanses us from ALL SIN.

- 1. Isaiah 38:17: Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but Thou hast in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: for Thou hast cast all my sins behind Thy back.
- 2 Jeremiah 33:8: And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against Me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against Me.
- 3. Ezekiel 36:25: Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you.
- 4. Matthew 12:31: Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Spirit shall <u>not</u> be forgiven unto men.
- 5. Luke 7:47: Wherefore I say unto thee, her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.
- 6. Colossians 2:13: And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath He quickened together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
- 7. Titus 2:14: Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

- 8. 1 John 1:7: But if we walk in the Light, as He is in the Light, we have fellowship one with another, and the Blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- 9. 1 John 1:9: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.



SUMMARY If we confess ALL of our sins, God will cleanse us from ALL. As God is True and cannot lie, you shall have full forgiveness and also cleansing from every sinful stain, just like He promised.
