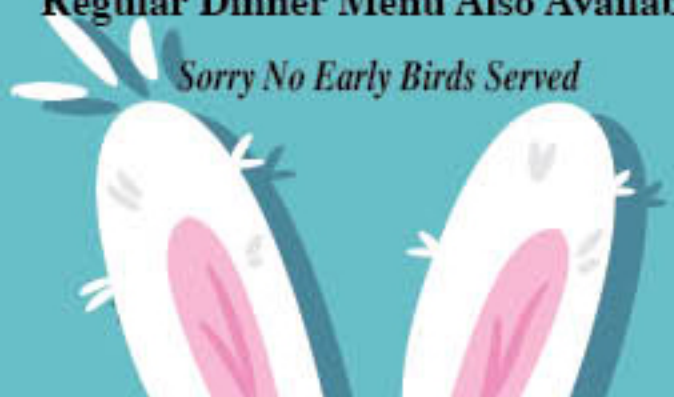

WHAT'S IT ALL ABOUT ALFIES?

Alfies restaurant
has always been a family affair since
1969. When Bud and Betty Evans
opened their first restaurant in 1969
they had three children. In the next
few years their passion for the business would help it grow to
where they expanded 5 times in 10 years. Today the
restaurant seats about 225 people and is open 6 days a week
lunch and dinner in Jamestown New York. It will be ap-
proaching its 50th year next year.

Bud and Betty had several restaurants over the years. In
Warren PA they were open in 1970 for 1 year at a diner called
"Uncle Al's". In the 80's they opened "Danny's Place" in
Frewsburg New York which we had for 2 years. Also in the
80's they opened a place called "Cookies Place" in Gerry
New York, which was an ice cream shop, take out hot dogs
and sandwiches. Cookies was open for about 3 years. In
Florida, Bud and Betty had Alfies in Flagler Beach from 1981
to 1986 before they opened up here in Ormond. In the 1990's
we opened a sandwich shop in Keystone Heights called Al-
fies which was open for a year. In 1993 we opened Alfies in
Ocklawaha Florida (near Ocala), which my younger brother
is still there. In between all this there was "Alfies Farm" in
Sherman New York. For about 15 years we tried to be farm-
ers with Dairy Cows, then Beef Cows, and lastly Bison. We
were not very good farmers but had some the best times of
our lives there. Bud and Betty also opened a gift shop called
"Alaines Originals" named after my sister in Jamestown
New York in the 80's. Later they converted that into "Evans
Discount Liquors", which is still going strong today operated
by my brother Dan and his wife Connie. If 1992 Dad and I
opened Alfies Liquors in Ocala which after 1 year we moved
it to Keystone Heights where it still serves today. Bud and
Betty Evans were amazing people. They adopted 4 children,
including myself at age 19. It's a long story but they were
loving people and I miss them.
They both died young and
only got to meet 2 of their
15 grandchildren. Live your life
everyday and love your family.
