

TURBO SPY TRACKER - FAST INSTALLATION & USAGE

If you have installed a software in the past then you can easily proceed with the following steps:

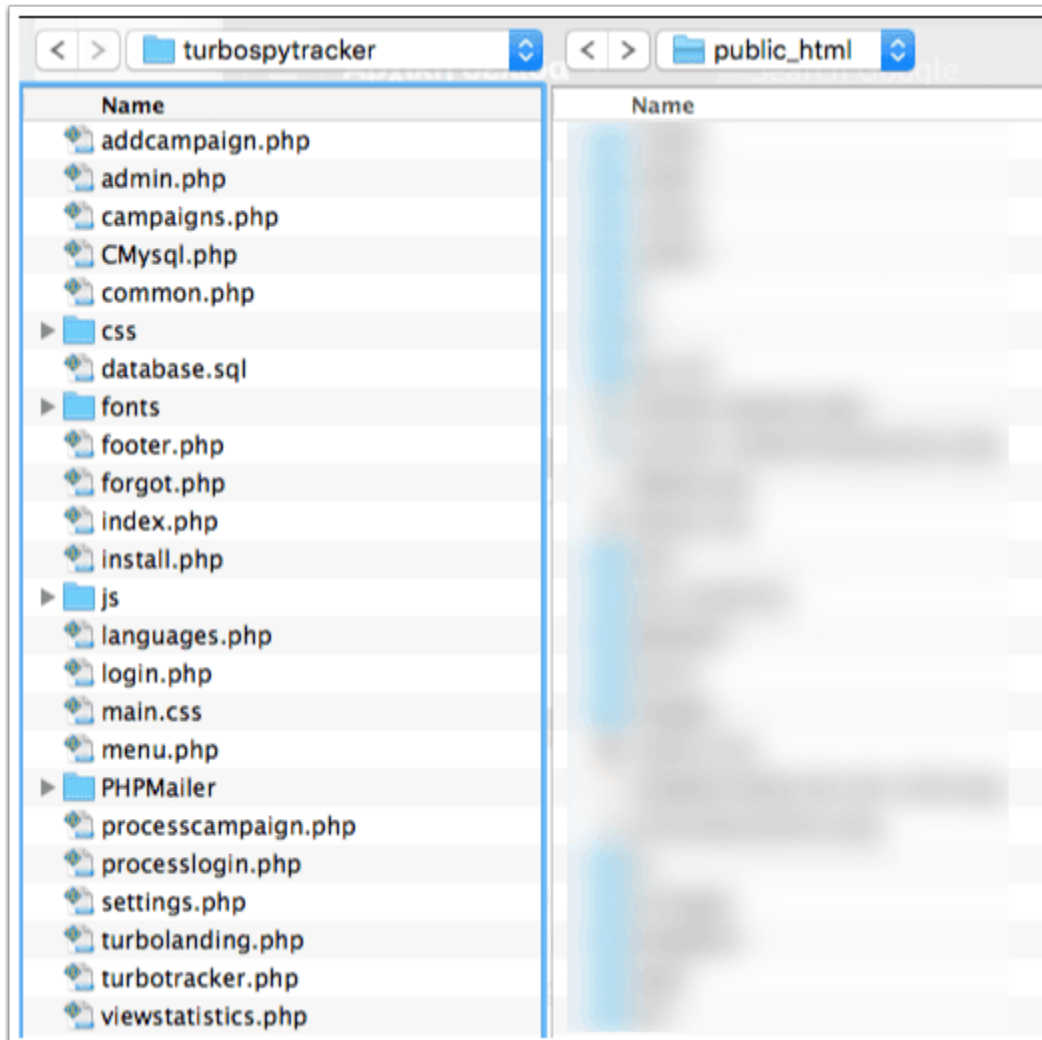
- Create the directory on your server
- Upload the files of the script inside the new directory
- Create a MySQL database, a new user and assign the user to the new database with all privileges
- Go to <http://domain.com/directory> whereas "domain.com" is your domain name and "directory" the directory where you uploaded all files, insert your database info and install the software
- Login on the next screen
- Edit Settings
- Select the "Your Trackers" option and click on the button to add a tracker
- You have the option to activate your Facebook Pixel ID within a tracker; look for instructions below.

If you never have installed a software on your server, you may proceed with the steps below.

An installation service may be offered by the vendor that sold you the software; you may contact the helpdesk for the availability.

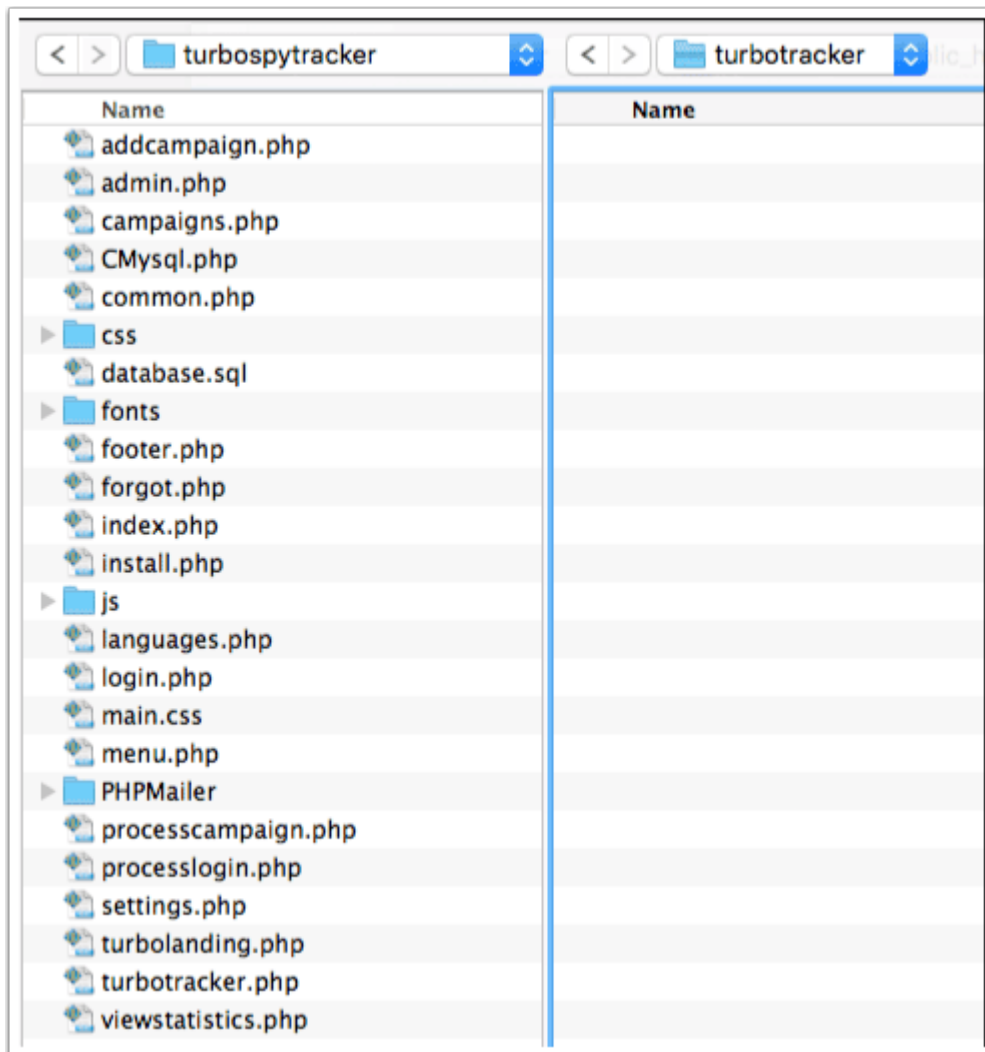
Login to your server

You can use any FTP software to login to your server, like FileZilla that can be found at <https://filezilla-project.org/>.

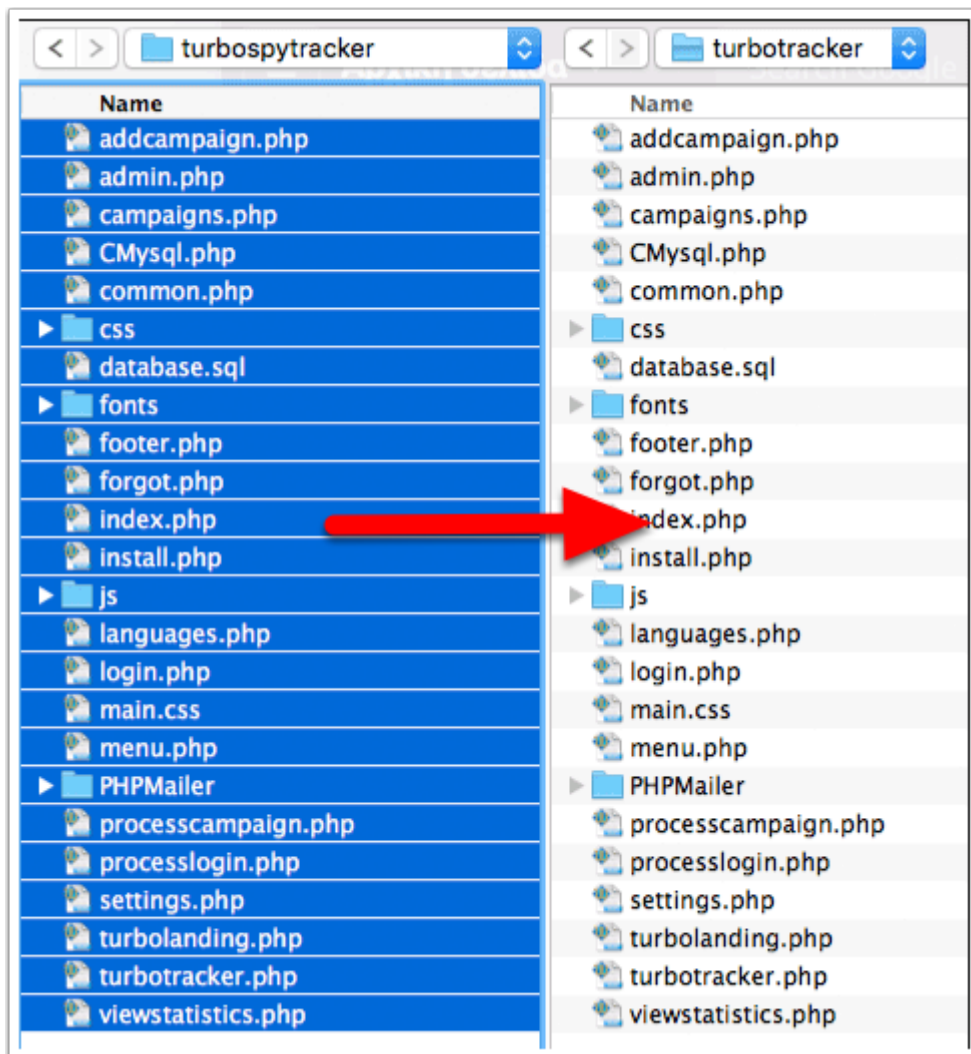


Create a directory

You can name it turbotracker or you can give any name you want.

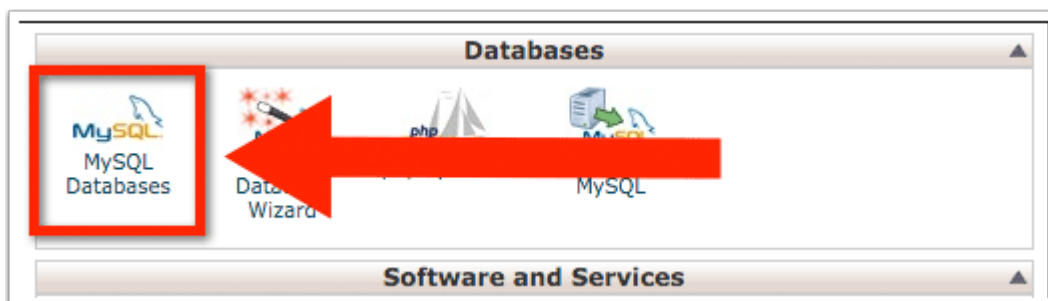


Upload all files




Login to cPanel

Scroll down until you see the "MySQL Databases" icon and click on it.



Create a new database


Give it a title and click on the button to create the database. Write down both the title of the database you created for you're going to need them when installing the software.

Go back to cPanel


Once your database is saved click on the "Go Back" icon to return to your cPanel.

Create a MySQL user

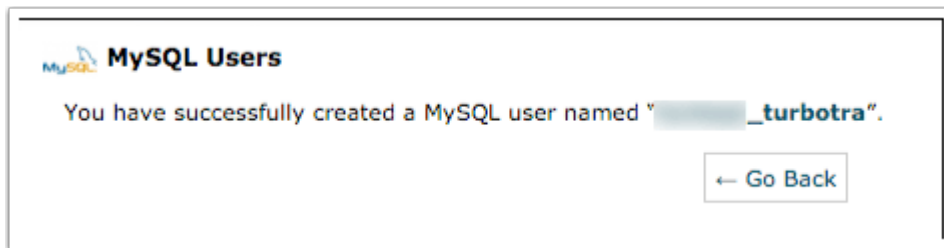
You need to give a username (1), then a password twice (2) (3) and click on the button (4) to create a user. Write down both the username and password you created for you're going to need them when installing the software.

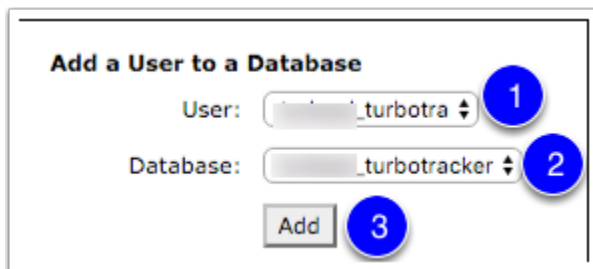
Go back to cPanel

Once your new user click on the "Go Back" icon to return to your cPanel.




Add user to the database

Select the User (1) and the Database (2) you created from the drop down menu and click on the button (3) to add the user to the Database.



Assign ALL PRIVILEGES

On the next screen check the box "ALL PRIVILEGES" (1) and once all checkboxes are selected click on the button (2) to save the changes.

Install the software

Go to <http://domain.com/directory> whereas "domain.com" is your domain name and "directory" the directory where you uploaded all files. Insert the name of your database (1) the username (2) of the user you created, the password of the user (3) too and click on the button (4) to install the software.



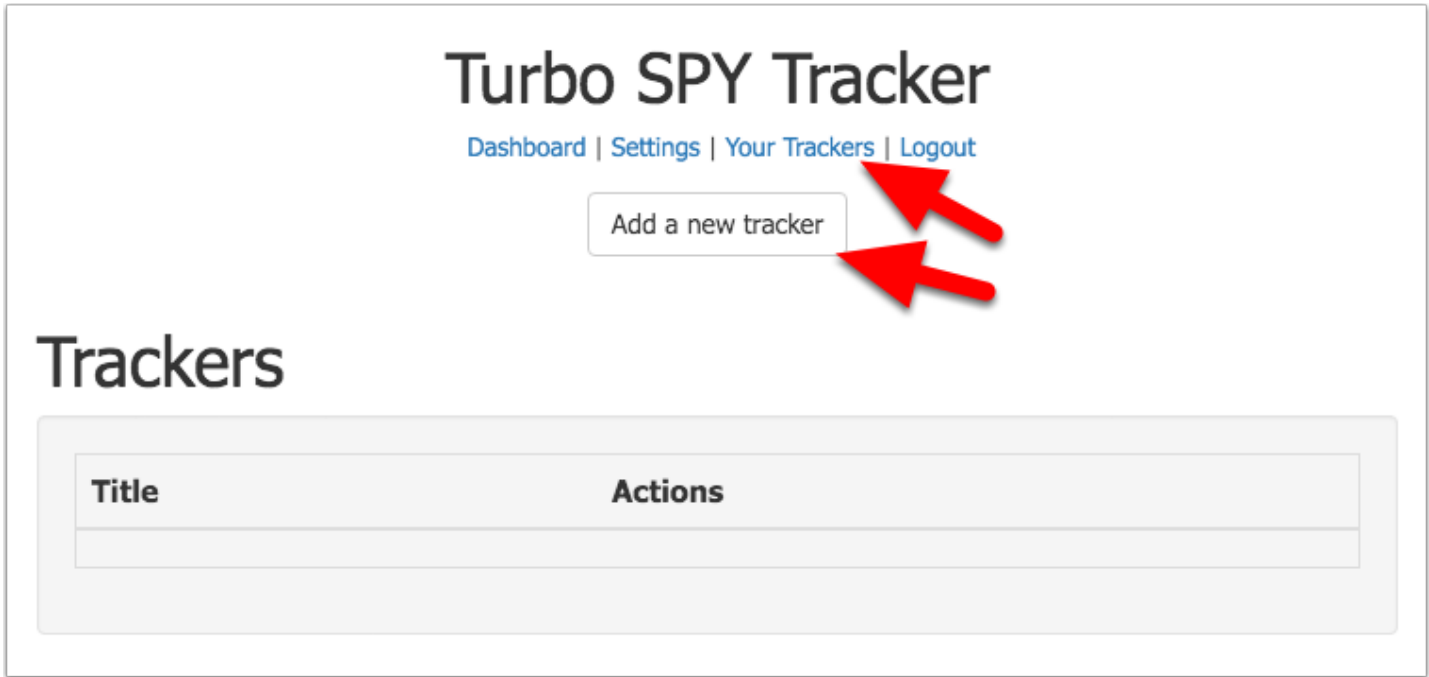

Add your first tracker


Click on the "Your Trackers" option and then on the button to add a tracker.



Adding a tracker - in detail

You can give a title (1) for the tracker, type in a Cost per click (2) (if you want to use the tracker to a CPC campaign) and you can also activate your Facebook Pixel (3), then Save (4) the changes.

BOTH THE COST PER CLICK AND THE FACEBOOK PIXELS FIELDS ARE OPTIONAL, SO IF THEY SAY NOTHING TO YOU, LEAVE THEM BLANK.

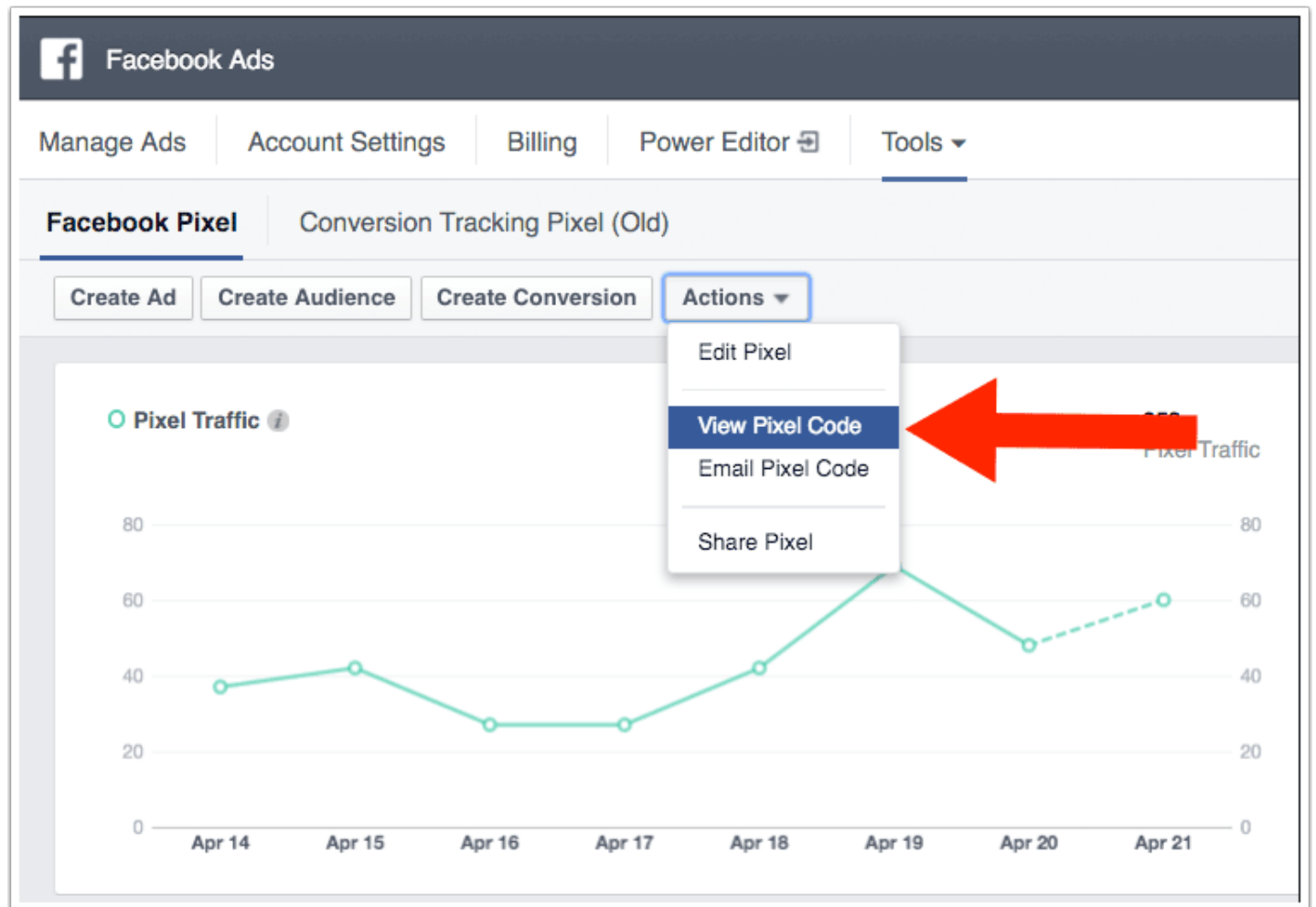
How to locate your Facebook Pixel ID

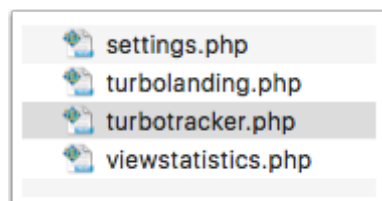
Add Conversion Tracking

You can also add events to track specific actions. Copy the code for the event you want to track, and paste it after the pixel code on the web pages where you want to track the action. Keep in mind standard event codes are case-sensitive. [Learn about conversion tracking.](#)

Name	Description	Event Code
ViewContent	Track key page views (ex: product page, landing page or article)	fbq('track', 'ViewContent');
Search	Track searches on your website (ex. product	fbq('track', 'Search');

Edit turbotracker.php

Open the turbotracker.php. Replace YOUR_FACEBOOK_PIXEL_ID with your Facebook Pixel ID. There are 2 instances to replace. Once done save the changes and upload the updated file inside the directory where you uploaded the files of the software - *overwriting the old one*.



Activate your Facebook Pixel ID in a tracker

For activating your Facebook Pixel ID with a certain tracker add this line

fbq("track", "ViewContent");

in the textarea (1) and save (2) the changes.

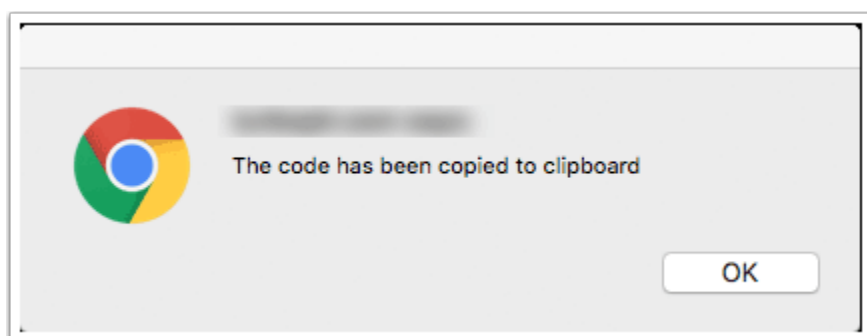
Copy the tracker's code
