

If you have been prescribed liquid medication for inhalation, nebulizers are used to change the liquid into a fine mist which allows it to reach deep into the lungs where it can be most effective.

## **Getting ready**

Put the unit on a firm, flat surface



Plug the power cord into an electrical outlet.



Connect one end of the tubing to the bottom of the cup and the other end to the air outlet on the unit.



## **Taking your medication**

Assemble your nebulizer cup and add your prescribed medicine.



Turn the power switch on "l" to begin your treatment.



When taking a treatment, sit upright and relaxed.



When your treatment is complete, turn the power switch off "O" and unplug the unit.



## **Cleaning your compressor**

- Unplug the unit before cleaning.
- Check the filter at least once each week. and replace when dirty.



Use a damp cloth to wipe down the outside of the compressor at least once each month.



## Cleaning your nebulizer

- After each use, take apart your SideStream top, medicine cup, baffle and mouthpiece.
- Wash in warm soapy water.
- Rinse in clean, cold water. Shake out excess water and allow to air dry.

If you have a reusable nebulizer (the light blue one) — Once a week, boil all parts (not the tubing or facemask) in water with 2–3 drops of dishwashing liquid
