2026 Convention Registration Sweepstakes
Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND OR ATTENDANCE AT ANY EVENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE, PAYMENT, ATTENDANCE AT ANY EVENT OR MEMBERSHIP IN THE MLTA WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

VOID WHERE PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED BY LAW.

1. Sponsor

This sweepstakes (“**Sweepstakes**”) is sponsored by the Minnesota Land Title Association (“**MLTA**”), a Minnesota non-profit corporation.

2. Eligibility

The Sweepstakes is open only to business entities (including corporations, limited liability companies, and partnerships) that are duly licensed and authorized to conduct business in Minnesota as abstracters, title insurance agents, and real estate closing agents (collectively hereinafter the “**Agents**” and each individually an “**Agent**”).

Agents who are affiliated with board members and officers of the MLTA and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate.

3. How to Enter

Agents who are currently MLTA members in good standing will automatically be entered into the Sweepstakes.

Alternative Method of Entry – Entry by E-Mail. In the alternative, for those Agents who are not currently MLTA members, Agents may submit via e-mail, the Agent’s company name, complete address, phone number, and email address, and send it to t.schipper@dcatitle.com with the subject heading “*Convention Registration Sweepstakes*”. The receipt of each e-mailed entry will be based on the delivery date and time and must be received by the MLTA before the Submission Deadline (as hereinafter defined) to be considered eligible to

win. MLTA is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, inaccurate, invalid, unintelligible, illegible, or misdirected entries or entries caught in any firewall or spam filter.

Entries may be submitted commencing on March 30, 2026 at 8:00 a.m. Central Time (“**CT**”) and ending on April 6, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. CT (the “**Submission Deadline**”). Entries received after the Submission Deadline or prior to March 30, 2026 are void. MLTA must receive all entries on or before the Submission Deadline as determined by MLTA’s clock.

Incomplete or incorrect entries are void.

By entering, each participant accepts and agrees to these Official Rules and all decisions of MLTA, which shall be final.

Each eligible entity will receive one (1) entry in the drawing. Limit one (1) entry per eligible entity.

4. Prize

Five (5) eligible Agent winners randomly drawn from the entries will each receive one (1) free individual registration to MLTA’s 2026 Annual Convention (the “**Free Registration**”). Total approximate value of each registration is \$400.00.

Odds of winning will depend on the total number of eligible entries received.

The Free Registration:

- Is valid for one (1) registration fee for an individual to attend MLTA’s 2026 Annual Convention.
- The Free Registration does not include travel expenses, such as hotel accommodations, meals or other expenses, which shall be the sole responsibility of the individual attending.
- Must be redeemed and applied to an individual attending MLTA’s 2026 Annual Convention by registering for and attending MLTA’s 2026 Annual Convention.
- Has no cash value and may not be redeemed for cash or any other form of compensation or other substitution.
- Is non-transferable to any other Agent and may not be combined with other offers unless explicitly stated.
- Does not obligate the winner to attend MLTA’s 2026 Annual Convention or make a purchase.

Any prize awarded will be issued to the selected entity, which shall designate the individual who will use the registration. The Free Registration may be applied only if the winner selects an individual to attend MLTA’s 2026 Annual Convention and redeems the Free Registration by registering the individual to attend the 2026 MLTA Annual Convention. In the event the winner fails to register an individual for the 2026 MLTA Annual Convention, the Free Registration provided to the winner will expire and may no longer be redeemed.

5. Drawing and Notification

Winners will be selected in random drawings conducted live on April 6, 2026, during the MLTA's 2026 Spring Seminar, using any method that MLTA deems as fair and just for all participants. Participants do not need to be present at the MLTA's 2026 Spring Seminar at the time of the drawing to win.

Potential winners drawn will be notified in-person at the MLTA's 2026 Spring Seminar, or if not in attendance, by e-mail. If applicable, winners will be issued an IRS Form 1099 for the actual retail value of the prize. Winners may be required to confirm eligibility and provide any information reasonably requested by the MLTA in order to claim the prize.

In the event a participant drawn is ineligible to receive the prize, MLTA shall draw another participant at random until a participant is drawn who is eligible to receive the prize. All income taxes resulting from acceptance of the prize, if any, are the responsibility of the winner.

All decisions of MLTA on matters pertaining to the Sweepstakes are at the sole discretion of the MLTA and are final and binding in all matters.

6. General Conditions

The MLTA reserves the right to cancel, suspend, or modify the Sweepstakes if any fraud, technical failures, or any other factor beyond its reasonable control impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Sweepstakes or prevents MLTA from holding its 2026 Spring Seminar. MLTA reserves the right to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or violating these Official Rules.

7. Limitation of Liability

By entering, participants agree to release and hold harmless the MLTA and its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, volunteers and agents from any and all liability for any injuries, loss, or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with the Sweepstakes or receipt or use of any prize. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THE FOREGOING MAY NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN PARTICIPANTS.

The MLTA is not responsible for and cannot be held liable for any technical errors that may prevent the Sweepstakes from running as planned, or for any circumstances that prevent the MLTA from holding its 2026 Spring Seminar or its 2026 Annual Convention. The MLTA will not be responsible for: lost, late, misdirected, damaged, corrupted, illegible, incomplete, incorrect prize notices; or any typographical, or other error in the printing of the offer, administration of the Sweepstakes, or announcement of the prizes. In the event of any such error, the MLTA reserves the right to cancel or modify this Sweepstakes in a manner deemed appropriate by the MLTA, at the MLTA's sole discretion. All applicable federal and state laws apply.

8. Governing Law

This Sweepstakes is governed by the laws of the State of Minnesota, without respect to conflict of law doctrines. Any disputes arising under this Sweepstakes shall be resolved exclusively in the state or federal courts located in Minnesota.

9. Publicity

Except where prohibited, participation in the Sweepstakes constitutes the winner's consent to the MLTA's use of their name, likeness, and entry for promotional purposes in any media without further payment or consideration.

10. Participant's Personal Information

Information collected from entrants will be used by the MLTA solely for purposes of administering the Sweepstakes and related communications.
