Kentucky Relief Challenge Campaign Raises \$258,034

- Rogers Group Sponsored fundraiser for tornado victims raised over \$258,000 for United Way of the Pennyrile through the Kentucky Relief Challenge campaign.
- From December 15, 2021, through January 10, 2022, Rogers Group employees donated funds through United Way's website. RGI's different SMAs competed against one another to see which one could raise the most money.
- Donations through the campaign from employees, the Rechter family, customers and suppliers totaled \$158,034. RGI's match of \$100,000 brought the total to \$258,034.
- These funds are already at work helping those affected by the tornadoes to put their homes and lives back together.
