Audit Overview





What is a Coding Audit

- Examines and evaluates the medical record to ensure services rendered are documented appropriately and reported on the medical claim accurately.
 - Review of clinical records, including but not limited to, progress notes, orders, labs, diagnostic imaging, procedures, and claim forms
 - Separate and distinct from a billing audit

Benefits of Coding Audits

- Ensure and/or improve coding accuracy
- Optimize reimbursement
- Discover process improvement opportunities
- Prevent or correct compliance concerns
- Decrease risk of external payer audits



Audit Types and Approaches





Professional Fee Coding Audit

Focused on an individual healthcare professional's personal service, including procedures and supplies.



Facility Fee Coding Audit

Resource driven based on services, medical equipment, supplies, room/board, etc., rendered during an admission to a healthcare facility.

Per date of service

- Evaluation and Management (E/M services)
- CPT procedural services
- ICD-10-CM diagnoses
- Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS)

ICD-10-CM

- ICD-10-PCS
- **Diagnostic Related Groups** (DRGs)

Based on the entire admission

Discharge status

CMS-1500 claim form

UB-04 claim form

Audit Approach

Prospective

- Review occurs prior to claim submission
- Specific/targeted services
- Goal is to identify and prevent coding errors before a claim goes out
- Clean claims equal quicker reimbursement
- May require an abundance of resources

Retrospective

- Review occurs after the claim has been submitted
- Random or targeted services
- Goal is to identify underlying problems, areas of high-risk, and/or revenue opportunities
- Time to gather data, analyze, and develop corrective action
- Doesn't prevent incorrect claims from going out

Internal Monitoring and Auditing



Conducted by staff of the organization



Structured to meet the needs of the facility



Driven by the company's compliance plan



Identifies errors in documentation, coding, billing and processes



Easily used to identify trends



Goal is to improve quality in the organization



Conducted by an outside entity



May be voluntary or mandated



Supports internal compliance program



Leverages perspectives from a variety of organizations and industry best practice



Eases burden to internal staff



Goal is to improve quality in the organization

External Monitoring and Auditing

Types of External Audits

Voluntary

- Focus on prevention and maintenance
- Performed regularly
- Targeted or random

Involuntary

- Insurance/ payer audits
- Department of Justice
- Office of Inspector General



Steps to Performing an Audit




Coding Audit Frequency
