Civilian Marksmanship Program Garand / Springfield 1903/A3 / Vintage Military Rifle Match

Location & Directions to the Range: 4866 Ravenswood Rd Kimball, MI 48074. Check in at the clubhouse out front. Club doors open at 0700.

Competition is open to: Any eligible competitor. You need not be a member of the NRA, CMP, or the sponsoring club. All competitors must have a notarized "Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement" on file at the sponsoring club or present at registration. Per CMP rule 2.1, no person convicted of a felony shall be allowed to participate in CMP sanctioned events.

Entry Fee: \$20

Entries Close: 0800, day of the clinic or when all slots on the line are full.

Firing Starts: 0930, safety briefing at 0915

Rules: Current Edition of CMP Rules

Rifles Allowed: US Service Rifles (Springfields 1903 / A3, M1 Garands, M1 Carbines, US Rifle M1917), Vintage Service Rifles (KAR98k, Lee Enfield, and others), 8mm bore maximum. All rifles must be in good working order. Rifles will be inspected for safety and function per CMP Games Rule 4.2 As-Issued Military Rifles.

Course of Fire: CMP course 'B' 50 rounds at 200 yards.

20 shots slow prone + 5 sighters  
10 shots rapid prone  
10 shots rapid sitting  
10 shots offhand

Note: This match will be fired on electronic targets. There will be no pit duty. Competitors will serve as score verifiers and recorders (you will write the score displayed on the tablet for each shot, and will handle issues on the line just as in a regular paper target match). The electronic targets will be verified before the match. Scoring and protests will be handled per the latest edition of the CMP rules. Also note that for 2023 CMP requires eye protection to be worn on the firing line.

Awards: CMP GSVM Pins. Scores will be submitted to the CMP for your CMP classification.
