## Membership Categories

### Active Member:

- An individual who is directly employed in management or administrative support services by an entity formally organized to provide or facilitate the provision of healthcare services.
  - An individual employed by a management organization, hospital/health system, practice management firm or other business entity responsible for managing any operational component(s) of an entity providing healthcare services. This includes consultants who are responsible for operations of one or more practices on an ongoing basis.
  - Healthcare providers/clinicians who hold an active license in the state are also considered active members.
- Active Dues are \$150 and includes membership in one local chapter.** (If your practice has more than 5 members please contact our office for reduced pricing.)

### Affiliate Member:

Any individual employed by an organization that provides products or services as a vendor to medical practices, or any individual who does not meet the requirements for active membership, but who subscribes to the purposes and activities of the Association. **Affiliate Dues are \$300 and includes membership in one local chapter. Affiliates that wish to be a member of all 5 Texas Local Chapters, dues are \$750.**

### Student Member:

An individual who is pursuing a healthcare or business-related degree at an accredited institution of higher learning and does not qualify for any other member category. **Student Dues are \$30 and includes membership in one local chapter.**
