State Conventions

One of the major activities of the Association since its inception has been the Annual Convention. In the early years, the event was one or two days with local squads serving as the host for the meeting. The Board of Governors would meet to conduct the business, first aid contests would be held and a parade would take place in the host city.

For the first 15 years of the Association, most of the Conventions were held within a one hour drive of Roanoke. But during the 1950's, the meetings began to move around the state with local squads bidding to host the event.

The first Convention held in Virginia Beach was in 1961 and since that time the majority of Conventions have been at the beach with only occasional returns to Roanoke.

Attendance at the event grew from less than 100 attending in the early days, to the early 1970's, when over 2,000 members and guests would attend the Convention. Squads would send large delegations to participate in the various contests held during the convention. The Awards Banquet on Saturday night was one of the highlights of the Convention when the results of the many competitions for the year were announced. In 1978, due to increased costs the banquet became an optional event and in 2005 it was eliminated.

Trophies are presented in multiple categories to recognize the outstanding competition teams. In the early years, the only contest was in first aid with all teams competing at one time in a large parking lot. Local American Red Cross instructors were recruited to help with judging the contests. Equipment judging was added in the 1950's to display the various ambulance conversions. In the early years, standard vehicles were converted to ambulance.

es and squads liked to show off their work at the Convention. For many years, the Virginia Truckers Association provided most of the trophies for the Convention. Today over 50 trophies are presented to recognize "Virginia's Finest" in the annual competitions.

Following is a summary of the Convention dates and locations. One of the most interesting facts about the convention history has to do with the numbering of the Conventions. Due to World War II, no Convention was held in 1945, but the BOG met on September 25, 1945 at Virginia Bridge Company to conduct business and elect officers. The subsequent minutes referred to the 1946 Convention as #11 and not #12. This numbering system that skipped 1945 continued until the 1980's when the 1945 meeting was again counted as a Convention. In any event, 2009 will mark the 75th meeting of the Board of Governors of the Association.
