

Virginia Association of First Responders Life Saving & Rescue Hall of Fame Application

NOMINEE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Nominee applications must be submitted by a member squad or crew of the VAFR, AVAVRS or the Life Saving & Rescue Hall of Fame.
- Applications must be received by the VAFR State Office no later than MARCH 1st of each year in order for the application to be considered for the following Convention.
- All information in support of the nominee must be submitted with the COMPLETED application.
- A quality black & white photo of the nominee must accompany the application.

NOMINEE CRITERIA (must meet 3 of the following)

- 1. Must be a member of a VAFR volunteer rescue squad or squads for a total of at least 15 years
- 2. Must hold or have held a leadership position in the VAFR
- 3. Must have contributed to the community by promoting his/her rescue squad by serving on an EMS council or board
- 4. Must be or have been a VAFR instructor
- 5. Must have designed a training manual
- 6. Must have designed or developed a rescue vehicle
- 7. Must have provided exemplary pre-hospital patient care in his/her community

NOMINEE ACCOMPLISHMENTS: A summary of the nominee's accomplishments (not to exceed 1,000 words) must be included in the application. The committee's decision will be based on the not only the nominee meeting the requirements of induction, but also the strength of the nominee's accomplishments as detailed in the application. Also, please ensure proper grammar, punctuation and spelling.

No more than 3 nominees will be inducted into the Hall of Fame each year. Note that the committee is under no obligation to select an inductee in any given year if the nominees for that year do not meet the requirements of admission.
