# Regional EMS Council Realignment

Effective January 1, 2026

The Virginia Office of EMS will transition from 11 Regional EMS Councils to 7, aligning EMS regions with other statewide public safety divisions.

- Current 11 councils remain in place through December 31, 2025
- New regional system officially launches January 1, 2026
