



INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL

Use this calendar to comply with the record keeping required by EPA and the MDEQ Dry Cleaning Program for air program compliance. Keep these records at your facility for at least five years.

PETROLEUM purchases could be kept the same way. This is not required, but a good idea.

CONDENSER

Check the outlet temperature of the refrigerated condenser every week. Record the temperature and date in the space provided. In the block marked "Is temp less than or equal to 45°F (7.2°C) Check "Yes" for yes and "N" for no. If you checked "N", the machine must be repaired.

INSPECTIONS

If you buy 140 gallons or more of perc per year, you must check your machine weekly for leaks and record the results.

If you buy less than 140 gallons of perc per year, you must conduct and record leak inspections at least every other week.

Record the results of the inspections on the calendar. If leaks are found, they must be repaired within 24 hours. Indicate in the "Date Repaired" block when repairs are completed. If parts must be purchased, indicate the dates they are ordered within two working days of leak detection and installed within five working days of receipt.

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FACTS ABOUT DRYCLEANING NESHAP

By now, every dry cleaner should be familiar with the regulations created by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to control perchloroethylene (perc) air emissions in 1993. You may hear this rule being referred to as NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) or as a MACT Standard (Maximum Achievable Control Technology). Regardless of what it is called or where your facility is located, if you are a dry cleaner using perchloroethylene, this regulation will affect you. This summary describes NESHAP and outlines your requirements. While the summary should help you understand whether you are affected, it is not a substitute for reading and understanding the rule.

DOES THIS STANDARD AFFECT MY BUSINESS?

This standard affects any dry cleaning machine using perchloroethylene. How this regulation affects your business depends on the date you installed your machine(s) and your source size. The type of machine(s) determines source size in your facility, and the amount of perc you purchase.

1. *New or Existing Machine.* How this regulation affects your facility, first determine whether your machine is new or existing.

- New Machines are those installed on or after December 9, 1991.
- Existing machines are those installed before December 9, 1991.

2. *Source Size.* Next, you will need to know what source size you are by using the following factors in Table 1. Anytime you install a machine, your source size that time and thereafter determines the requirements for that machine.

- *Type of Machine:* The standard divides perc dry cleaning machines into two types: dry-to-dry and transfer. In a dry-to-dry system, one machine does all the washing and drying of fabrics. A transfer system uses at least two machines: a washer and dryer or reclaimer.

- *Amount of Perc Purchased:* The standard requires that each month you determine the amount of perc your purchased for the previous year. You will need to know the total volume (in gallons) of perc you purchased for all the machines in your facility for the current month, and add it to the amount of perc you purchase in the previous 11 months.

DETERMINING YOUR SOURCE SIZE

Any time you install a machine you should determine its source size at that time and every month thereafter to see which requirements apply to that machine. Use the following schedule:

For any existing machine installed at your facility before October 1, 1996 and any new machine installed before September 22, 1993 its source size is determined on September 1, 1991 and each month thereafter. Look at your perc consumption from September 1, 1995 to August 31, 1996.

For any existing machine relocated at your facility on October 1, 1996 or later, and any new machine installed September 23, 1993 or later its source size is based on the amount of perc purchased for the previous 12 months. Look at the first day in which the machine was installed and each month thereafter.

Requirements for any machine can never be reduced, even if your purchased less perc. However, if you lower your yearly perc consumption, any machine installed during times of lower yearly perc consumption could benefit from reduced requirements.

If you increase your yearly perc consumption and your source size changes, you must comply with any applicable additional requirements within 180 days and submit a new Notification of Compliance Status to the Dry Cleaning Program within 210 days.

HOW DOES MY BUSINESS COMPLY WITH THIS STANDARD?

The requirements of this standard that apply to you depend on your source size and whether you have new or existing machines. Different machines may be subject to different requirements.

The Following requirements are organized by:

- A. All Machines
- B. New Machines
- C. Existing Machines at Large Area Sources
- D. Machines at Major Sources

A. ALL MACHINES

All dry cleaners affected by this regulation need to comply with Requirements 1-1, immediately. (These are only requirements for existing machines at small area sources. Other machines have the additional requirements in Sections B-D.)

1. Keep perc purchase receipts onsite for five years.
2. On the first business day of each month, based on receipts. Also, keep a running record of your annual amount of perc consumption. (This is the sum of all perc purchases made in the prior 12 months.)
3. Keep all perchlorethylene in closed, non-leaking containers.
4. Drain Cartridge Filters in their housing or sealed containers for at least 24 hours.

5. Keep machine doors closed, unless loading and unloading fabrics.
6. Operate and maintain equipment according to the manufacturer's instructions. To meet this requirement, you will need to have your owner's manual on-site.
7. For machines installed at large or major area sources, inspections should be done once a week. Keep a written log of these inspections. The leak inspection can be done by detector, sight, smell or feel and must include:
 - Door gasket seating
 - Filter gasket and seating
 - Pumps
 - Solvent tanks and containers
 - Water separators
 - Hose and pipe connections, fittings, couplings and valves
 - Muck cookers
 - Stills
 - Exhaust dampers
 - Diverter valves
 - Cartridge filter housing
8. If you find leaks you must repair them within 24 hours.
9. If you need repair parts:
 - Order them within two days;
 - Install parts within five days or receipt;
 - Keep a written log or repair work, including the day parts were ordered, received and installed.
10. Keep all records for a minimum of five years.

B. NEW MACHINES

New transfer machines are prohibited. Any new machine (regardless of the source size) must comply with Requirements 1-10 and the following additional requirements.

11. Refrigerated Condensers: Install a dry-to-dry machine with a refrigerated condenser (“chillers”) upon startup.
 - The refrigerated condenser on a dry-to-dry machine must not release perc vapors into the atmosphere while the drum is rotating. To ensure this, the perc vapors should be recirculated back through the machine in a closed loop system so the vapor stream will pass through the refrigerated condenser several times.
 - If a refrigerated condenser pulls air through the door when the door is open after the cycle, then it must have a Diverter Valve. The Diverter Valve requirement only applies to vented dry cleaning machines. Non-vented (closed-loop) machines do not need Diverter Valves.
 - Once a week, measure and record the exhaust temperature on the outlet side of the refrigerated condenser. The temperature must be equal to or less than 45 F. If the temperature exceeds 45 F, make repairs or adjustments and keep records of your actions. The temperature sensor used must be operated according to the manufacturer’s instructions and have an accuracy of +/- 2 F. If the temperature exceeds 45 F, make repairs or adjustments and keep records of those repairs.
12. Carbon Absorbers: If you use a carbon absorber on a new machine, you can request approval of the use of a carbon absorber as an equivalent to condensers. Contact the Dry Cleaning Program at (800) 662-9278.

C. EXISTING MACHINES AT LARGE AREA SOURCES

Existing machines at large area sources must comply with Requirements 1-10 immediately and the following additional requirements. (Chose Requirement 13 or 14)

13. Refrigerated Condensers:
 - If using a refrigerated condenser on a dry-to-dry machine, reclaimer or dryer, once a week measure and record the exhaust temperature on the outlet side of the refrigerated condenser. The temperature must be equal to or less than 45 F. If the temperature exceeds 45 F, make repairs or adjustments and keep records of your actions. The temperature sensor used must be operated according to manufacturer’s instructions and have an accuracy of +/- 2 F.

- A vented machine operating with a refrigerated condenser must be operated with a Diverter Valve. The Diverter Valve prevents air being drawn into the dry cleaning machine when the door is open from passing through the refrigerated condenser. Gas vapors from the machine should not be released into the atmosphere when the machine drum is rotating.
- If you are using a refrigerated condenser on a washer, measure and record the temperature of the washer exhaust on both the inlet and outlet side of the condenser once a week. The temperature difference between the inlet and outlet must be 20 F or greater. The temperature sensors must be operated according to the manufacturer’s instructions and have an accuracy of +/- 2F. If the temperature difference is less than 20F, make repairs and adjustments and keep records of your actions.

14. Carbon Absorbers:

- Facilities that installed a carbon absorber to control process air emissions on an existing machine before September 22, 1993, may continue to use this device to comply with the rule requirements. With a carbon absorber, measure and record the concentration of perc in the carbon absorber exhaust within a colorimetric detector tube once a week. The measurement must be taken at the end of the last dry cleaning cycle prior to desorption.
- The concentration must be 100 ppm (parts per million) or less. If the concentration is greater than 100 ppm, make repairs or adjustments and keep records of your actions. (The colorimetric tube must be operated according to the manufacturer’s instructions and with accuracy of +/- 25 ppm per volume.)
- When using the colorimetric detector tube, you must have a sampling port in the exhaust outlet that is easily accessible and at a point equivalent to at least eight duct diameters downstream and at least two duct diameters upstream from many flow disturbance (i.e., a bend, expansion, contraction or outlet.)

All existing machines at large area sources need to have refrigerated condenser (“chiller”). Carbon absorbers installed on vents before September 22, 1993, may be used in place of the refrigerated condenser.

If you use a carbon absorber installed on or after September 22, 1993, on an existing machine, you can request the EPA to approve the use of carbon absorber as equivalent to condensers. Contact the Dry Cleaning Program at (800) 662-9278 for more information.
