

1 (2) Beginning June 1, 2032, a person shall not sell a dry
2 cleaning solvent that contains perchloroethylene.

3 (3) Beginning December 1, 2032, a person shall not use as a
4 dry cleaning solvent a product that contains perchloroethylene.

5 Sec. 14733. (1) The perchloroethylene fund is created in the
6 state treasury. The state treasurer may receive money or other
7 assets from any source for deposit into the fund. The state
8 treasurer shall direct the investment of the fund and credit to the
9 fund interest and earnings from fund investments. Money in the fund
10 at the close of the fiscal year remains in the fund and does not
11 lapse to the general fund. The department is the administrator of
12 the fund for auditing purposes.

13 (2) On appropriation, the department shall expend money from
14 the fund to do all of the following:

15 (a) Provide grants under the cost-share program provided for
16 in subsection (3).

17 (b) Provide information and resources about alternative
18 products, dry cleaning processes, and equipment.

19 (c) Provide information and resources regarding the cost-share
20 program provided for in subsection (3).

21 (3) The department shall promulgate rules in accordance with
22 the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201
23 to 24.328, to implement a cost-share program to provide grants to
24 dry cleaning facilities to cover the costs of transitioning from
25 products that contain perchloroethylene to alternative products,
26 and establish all of the following:

27 (a) Eligibility and selection criteria.

28 (b) Application requirements.

29 (c) Eligible alternative products, dry cleaning processes, and

1 equipment.

2 (d) A buy-back program to ensure safe disposal of existing
3 products that contain perchloroethylene from dry cleaning
4 facilities.

5 (4) The department shall make the information on the cost-
6 share program available on the department's website.

7 (5) As used in this section:

8 (a) "Department" means the department of environment, Great
9 Lakes, and energy.

10 (b) "Fund" means the perchloroethylene fund created in
11 subsection (1).

12 Sec. 14735. A person that violates section 14731 may be
13 ordered to pay a civil fine of not more than \$10,000.00. A
14 violation of section 14731 may be prosecuted by the prosecutor of
15 the county in which the violation occurred or by the attorney
16 general.
