If you desire to take the examination, please complete the enclosed application and return to this office together with the statutory fee of \$50.00 for retakes or \$75.00 for first exam on or before April 20th, 2021.

As a part of the examination you will need to prepare and bring with you an abstract of title as set out in the application. If you have prepared an abstract previously, another will not be required.

We would suggest that you bring with you to the examination, a straight edge, preferably with an engineers scale and protractor to be used in the drawing of legal descriptions. A small calculator is permissible if you wish to use one.
