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




Foundational: Architecture and Technology

Challenges

- Establishing a flexible architectural platform for interoperability
- Making key architectural decisions
 - Centralized vs. distributed
 - Core data model – materialized FHIR vs FHIR façade
- Making build vs buy decisions
- Choosing and managing vendor(s)
- Managing connectivity at scale

Opportunities

- Develop an architectural platform that will support interoperability needs into the future
- Create growth opportunities for technical staff



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Foundational: Human Resources and Organizational Readiness

Challenges

- Lack of skilled and available resources to manage program complexity
- Ownership and governance of member health data assets
- Scarcity of clinical data resources
- Funding for strategic value above base compliance
- Establishing and managing contractual agreements with providers and payers

Opportunities

- Begin to consider member health data a valuable enterprise asset

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Foundational: Member Consent

Challenges

- Establishing consent and preference management policy, governance and accountability amongst privacy, legal, clinical and IT
- Integration of member opt in and opt out with enterprise consent architecture
- Establishing level of granularity for consent
- Managing the intersection with state and federal privacy regulation
- Integration with action triggers as consent is granted/revoked

Opportunities

- Create an enterprise level consent and preference management platform

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Prior Authorization

Challenges

- Codifying medical policy and clinical guidelines for use in DTR
- Working with delegated entities
 - Obtain prior authorization transactional data in a timely manner to share with APIs
 - Routing and orchestration for CRD, DTR and PAS
- Developing a strategy for managing and sharing related structured and unstructured clinical information
- Implementation unknowns such as
 - Using clinical vs billing codes
 - Place of service
- Approach and availability of workflow apps for provider use by EHR and other vendors

Opportunities

- Simplify prior authorization policies
- Capitalize on a real return on investment with automation

Challenges	Opportunities
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Obtaining and managing member consent and previous payer identification • Establishing and managing payer connectivity • Developing and managing triggered and automated actions based on consent and/or concurrent payers • Member matching 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Making use of historical member health data for care planning, quality programs and risk adjustment
