- Goals as a Chapter Member: To bring fresh, innovative ideas to the chapter. To help promote
 manager professionalism to the general public by increasing awareness of CAI designations.
 Strengthen relationships between vendors, board members and managers. Continue to
 promote events where managers, vendors and board members can get to know each other in a
 low key, unintimidating environment.
- 2. Biggest challenges facing West Florida Chapter CAI and the community association industry: One of the biggest challenges as I see it is a general understanding from owners and board members of what management companies and managers do for them and their communities. Also how board members can distinguish between a professional management firm or professional manager with advanced designations through CAI from an non experienced, non credentialed company or individual just telling them what they want to hear. It seems that most board members as well as owners don't recognize the value of a professional organization or individual manager that has spent the time and money to further their professionalism through CAI and earning the advanced designations. Most don't even know what those designations are. I think there should be more time and effort promoting the benefits of partnering with a firm or manager that is involved with CAI. I also feel that CAI needs to do more to lesson the financial burden placed on management companies that are paying for individual memberships for their managers. The local chapter has seen a decline in involvement of the large, local management firms and it's my opinion that is largely due to the significant financial responsibility that is placed on those firms with not much perceived value for it.
- 3. What unique skills and abilities do I possess: I have the experience of over 20 years as a member of CAI but still have a fresh and innovative perspective to the industry. I have the experience of interacting with a lot of board members which gives me insight to their needs and perception of CAI and the industry.
