

Students eligible for assistance must be a U.S. citizen or documented permanent resident of the United States and reside in Manatee or Sarasota Counties (Florida). Applicants must be a member in good standing of Community Associations Institute (CAI) West Florida Chapter, or be related to such a member by blood, adoption or marriage. Previous recipients of this scholarship are eligible to apply in any succeeding competition for this award provided other requirements are satisfied. Scholarships are typically at or near \$500 each. One or more applicants may be selected each year.

Award is based on the applicant's interest in property management or property construction; extracurricular activities; employment experience if any; personal evaluations; applicant's requests; and financial need. Applicants may apply for the scholarship to assist in vocational, technical or certificate-based training, education, continuing education, or other programs that relate to the property management or construction industries, or for 2- or 4-year college degree programs related to those industries. Selection will be made without regard to the applicant's race, color, ethnic origin, religious belief, sex, marital status, or physical handicap.
