EVANGELIZE 2023

WHOSOEVER WILL

It is written in the prophet Joel—"And it shall come to pass
That whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved"
(Joel 2:32, NKJV). Regarding Joel 2:32—

1. It was targeted for the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:16-21)
2. It was a fulfillment for both Jews and Gentiles (Acts 10:34-43). It is therefore a world gospel (Rev. 14:6)!
3. It is conditioned upon the response of every man (Romans 10:12-13, 17)
4. The "name of the LORD" in Joel 2:32 is *Yahweh*. But, it is applied to Jesus Christ in Acts 10:36, 43; Romans 10:9, 13.

The gospel proposition is, *Whosoever will may come*. So, while the gospel is not for everyone: it is for anyone.

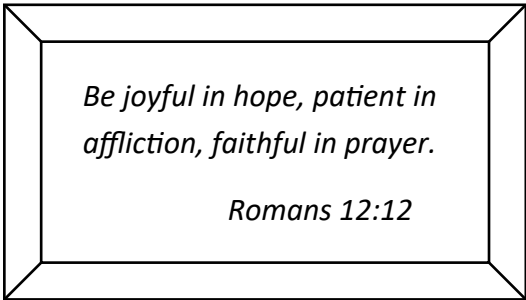
