WHEN JESUS WEPT

"I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears" (2 Kings 20:5)

There are three recorded times in the life of Jesus where it is written that he wept.

1. Jesus wept over the city of Jerusalem because the people did not recognize the time of their visitation (Lk. 19:41-44). The term here for weeping is *klaio: To break forth, wail* (Young, 1042).
2. Jesus wept in the Garden of Gethsemane out of a sense of personal *"horror and anguish"* (Mk. 14:33; Hebrews 5:7-8). The Hebrew writer uses the term *dakruo*, tears. The context indicates an intense emotional experience to establish his ability to empathize as a faithful high priest for his people.
3. And, Jesus wept at the cave tomb of Lazarus, his friend (John 11:35).

Jesus was invested in the people of Jerusalem; the mission of salvation; and the emotional cares of his people. Yes, Jesus wept for you.
