[Marcus Barth, The Broken Wall, Judson Press, 1959, p. 35]

Chap. 4 - The Equipping of God's People

Ephesians reminds us that the nature of the church and its relation to missions is not for a select group of specialists, or committee, but for <u>every Christian</u> to participate in the purpose of God's mission to the lost (4:12 is crucial).
