A SUMMARY OF EPHESIANS

[Marcus Barth, *The Broken Wall*, Judson Press, 1959, p. 35]

A brilliant summary of Paul's Letter to the Ephesians is suggested by Marcus Barth, son of Karl Barth. Ephesians 1 commences with the Father's purpose (1:4-6a); secondly to the work of the Son (1:6b-12); and thirdly in relation to the grace of the Holy Spirit (1:13-14).

Chap. 1 - The Ground-laying work of God
Chap. 2 - The Gathering
Chap. 3 - The Missions
Chap. 4 - The Equipping of God's People

Ephesians reminds us that the nature of the church and its relation to missions is not for a select group of specialists, or committee, but for every Christian to participate in the purpose of God's mission to the lost (4:12 is crucial).
