Dear brethren,

Greetings, grace, and peace be with you all in Christ Jesus. I pray you are well.

07/18/2025 – Our first day of the campaign in Grand Cayman. We door knocked in Georgetown with 17 people and made 25 hot contacts which want Bible studies. My group led one Bible Study with Patrick (BttB 1).

07/19/2025 – Day #2 We had several Bible studies and established many more studies for the next few days. Led Bible Study with Patrick (BttB 2).

07/20/2025 – Day #3 We split up into two groups to worship with both congregations West Bay CoC and Georgetown CoC. We had Jim Word and Charles Hall teach at Georgetown and Justin Hopkins and Tim Hall teach at West Bay. We had two Bible studies which we finished book #2 and start book 3. Fred Starks kicked off the Gospel meeting over Salvation is at your door.

07/21/2025 – Day #4 of Cayman Island Campaign. We continue to door knock and do Bible Studies. We had several studies rescheduled. We had one group does not get out of there Bible study till 8:30 last night after starting their first study at 9 am. My group was able to meet an apostate who has left the church and gave us her number to schedule a Bible study (I studied with her son).

07/22/2025 – Day #5 we rejoice at Aryln being added to the body of Christ. All groups were in several Bible studies, and many are getting to the point of salvation.



07/23/2025 – Day #6 We praise God for another receptive heart as Natasha Gemmell obeyed the Gospel. We had a long day of knocking doors and doing Bible studies. But the day ended praising God with a baptism and then going to the Gospel meeting with tons of visitors. We ended the meeting with giving out free bibles to all visitors which we were able to get their information and set up more Bible studies. Sang: "We are part of a family." Welcome our new sister in Christ Natasha Gemmell to the body of Christ. Sometimes you can't wait until the Gospel meeting is over. You got to get to the truth of salvation NOW. "Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (2 Cor 6:2, studied with Alrek, a 17-year-old teen).

07/24/2025 – We had a great evening after a busy day of Bible studies. There was a great turn out for fellowship from the saints here, and several guests from the community. Brother Jesse was talking to one guest and her Christian friend who brought her said, "we're planning to study the Bible together this weekend." One of our goals has been to equip and train the local brethren to continue the work of evangelism. Mission accomplished.

07/25/2025 - Day #7 We had a wonderful last day to wrap up a bunch of ongoing Bible studies, and visiting a bunch of contacts we made through the week. We ended the night with a fellowship meal with both congregations and a bunch of visitors we had through the week at meeting. This fellowship allowed more Bible studies to be set up. We also discussed with several of the men from the congregations to discuss future plans to possibly do more campaigns in the future.

07/26/2025 - The last day at Cayman. Everyone is currently fixing to fly back home to the states. But before we left we met with Matin the preacher at Georgetown Church of Christ along with his Son Rhon and his fiancé Rosie to handover all the contacts from door knocking in Georgetown. They already calling some and setting up further Bible studies and Rhon and Rosie are contacting all the younger ones under 30 to finish studying with but also to get connected with so they can hang out together to continue building relationships. Please continue to pray for Georgetown Church of Christ and WestBay Church of Christ as they continue the work. We had a total of 22 hot contacts in Georgetown and 13 at WestBay. We had several other contacts, but we nailed it down to those we performed a Bible Study. I hope you enjoy looking through the pictures.

I am thankful for the prayers and support you all are contributing so I may grow in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. The training is intense, but it is preparing us to preach with clarity and boldness. Please continue to pray for me as I continue to strengthen in the faith.
