*Every year Weathervane Music produces Shaking Through, a documentary video series designed to inspire and educate the public about the creative processes that go into recording music.*

Select artists come to Philadelphia from near and far for the opportunity to record one song in two days, while each episode is captured in beautiful video to share their experiences with the public. Perhaps the most extraordinary part of this wonderful program is that Weathervane Members also enjoy the rare benefit of being a part of the creative process itself, as they can download and remix the original multitracks from the recordings, and sharing them back with each other on Shaking Through episode pages.

The 2016 fiscal year began with three remarkable episodes. New York's **Pavo Pavo** recorded "Check the Weather" in an episode that preceded the band's signing with British label Bella Union. Chicago's **Haley Fohr** of **Circuit Des Yeux** collaborated with Philadelphia luminaries **John** and **Michael Gibbons** of **Bardo Pond** along with **Christopher Powell** and **Matt Gibson** of the band **Man Man**. **Paris France's The Dove & The Wolf** finished up the calendar year with a recording of their song Green and Yellow, collaborating with **Charlie Hall** of **The War on Drugs**, and former **Roots** bass player **Owen Biddle**.

In April 2016, the new season (Volume 7) began with former VH1 Make Or Break: The Linda Perry Project winner **Candice Martello** in her band **Hemming**, backed by members of Philadelphia's **Cayetana** and **Three Man**

**Cannon**. And in July, Weathervane released a new episode featuring **Big Thief** who recorded "Mother" with guest producer **Luke Temple** of **Here We Go Magic**. Both episodes combined the artist and production story into a single TV-friendly video format. This not only improved the coherence of Shaking Through videos, but consolidated costs and improved efficiency.

For the eighth year in a row, Weathervane enjoyed its partnership with **Miner Street Recordings**, the recording studio where Shaking Through, Recording Workshops and Private Studio Concerts are produced. In 2016 we also celebrated a new partnership with **Expressway Films**, a respected Philadelphia video production company who provided camera, lighting, and crew resources for each episode.

2016 was also a year in which new sponsorship relationships were created with recording equipment manufacturers like **Rode Microphones**, **Studio Logic Sound**, **Mountain King Audio**, **Earthquaker Devices** and **Dizengoff Audio**. Weathervane also continued to enjoy sponsorship relationships with **Rustica Pizza**, **Reanimator Coffee**, and **Philly Style Bagels**.

*The Weathervane EDU Program packages educational materials for instructors and their students learning the art and science of recording music.*

These unique materials include audio files from the extensive, growing catalog of Shaking Through and Weathervane Recording Workshops, along with special "how-to" texts outlining recording techniques developed in Weathervane recordings over the years.

Weathervane EDU was initially built with a leadership grant from The Muse Educational Foundation. Launched in fiscal year 2015, the program is still in its infancy, but shows remarkable promise. With support of the community, Weathervane EDU will not only provide a stable new stream of revenue, but it will also introduce the work and programs of Weathervane (Shaking Through, Recording Workshops and more) to a new, younger audience.

In 2016, 237 students studying under 14 instructors participated with Weathervane EDU materials. 1365 students studying under 44 instructors at 11 institutions have received access to these unique learning materials since the program pilot was created in fiscal year 2014.

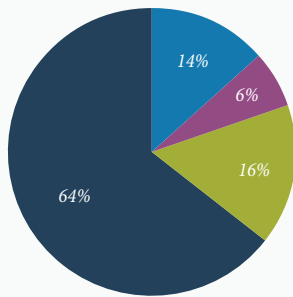

*Since 2011, Weathervane has been exploring new ways for our supporting members to explore the creative stages of making music.*

Since introducing Membership in 2013, Weathervane has provided the community with access to high quality audio files from every season of Shaking Through. By exploring the raw tracks, mix stems, and drum samples from these recordings, members learn about the fundamental building blocks of a song. With this, they understand all music, from the music of their youth, to songs they hear on the radio today, in profoundly new ways.

As members remix and share their reimagined versions of these songs, they compare approaches and techniques with the rest of the community. The result is an ongoing conversation that includes hundreds of people from all over the world. The listener becomes a part of the creative process - this is perhaps one of the most original and beautiful aspects of Weathervane's work.

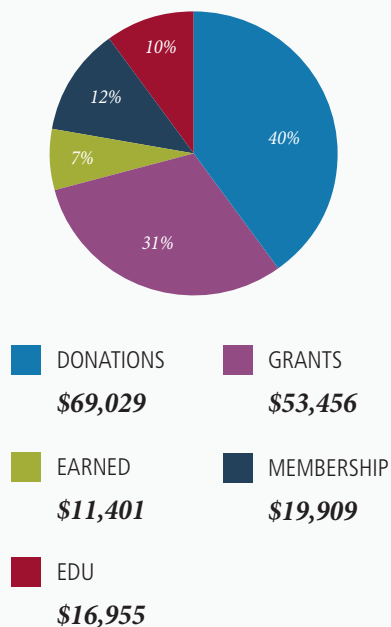
