Dung Quat refinery at a glance:

As the first refinery in Vietnam, Dung Quat refinery has a designed capacity of 6.5 million tons of crude oil annually, or 140 thousand barrels per day. Main contractors of the refinery were Technip, JGC Corporation, and Técnicas Reunidas. The refinery is owned and operated by Petrovietnam.

Processing oil from Bạch Hổ oil field, Dung Quat refinery comprises of overall refinery process, utilities and offsites facilities; flare area; crude tank farm; product tank farm; seawater intake, waste water, crude oil and interconnecting pipelines; and product harbour service area.


