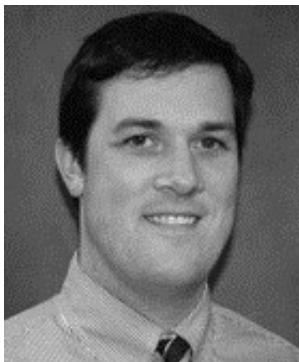

ARBO/OE Tracker App

Mid-Year 2016

The new OE Tracker app is available for download to your iPhone or Android phone.

You use this app to instantly send your attendance courses to OE Tracker/ARBO.

Once you have downloaded the app, open the app. You will see the Welcome screen, and you need to click Course Attendee. You will need your OE Tracker username and password to log into the OE Tracker app. If you do not know your username and password, you need to contact ARBO at (704) 970-2710.

Once you know your username and password, you may login to the app. You will see the main screen open. This screen will display your name, OE Tracker number, and email.

To record your attendance at a CE course, the WVAOP will post the QR code for you to scan after the course is over. You will need to click "Scan QR Code", which will open your phone's camera. Center the QR code on your screen and it will automatically scan. If you scan the QR code correctly, the confirmation screen will appear telling you that your attendance has been recorded. Please note: You only need to scan the QR code once to receive credit. Each course will have its own separate QR code.
