Contact lens patients can present with red eyes for a wide variety of reasons, some serious and some cosmetic. This course will present a clinical approach to sorting through possible etiologies, identifying the correct one, and providing the most appropriate treatment.

2018 Bronstein Seminar Faculty

Dr. Melissa Barnett is a Principal Optometrist at the UC Davis Eye Center in Sacramento. She is internationally recognized key opinion leader, specializing in anterior segment disease and specialty contact lenses. Dr. Barnett lectures and publishes extensively on topics including dry eye, anterior segment disease, contact lenses and creating a healthy balance between work and home life for women in optometry. She is a Fellow of the American Academy of Optometry, a Diplomate of the American Board of Certification in Medical Optometry (ABCMO), a Fellow of the British Contact Lens Association (BCLA) and serves on the Board of American Optometric Association (AOA) Cornea and Contact Lens Council, Women of Vision (WOV), Gas Permeable Lens Institute (GPLI), Ocular Surface Society of Optometry (OSSO) is Immediate Past President of The Scleral Lens Education Society (SLS). Dr. Barnett is a spokesperson for the California Optometric Association and a guest lecturer for the STAPLE program. She was awarded The Theia Award for Excellence for Mentoring by Women in Optometry (WO) in 2016. In her spare time she enjoys cooking, yoga, hiking and spending time with her family, Todd Erickson, also an optometrist, and two sons, Alex and Drew.

Mr. Patrick J. Caroline serves as Associate Professor at Pacific University College of Optometry in Forest Grove Oregon. He is a Fellow member and Diplomat of the Cornea and Contact Lens Section of the American Academy of Optometry. Patrick is a Council member of the International Society for Contact Lens Research as well as a member of the International Association of Contact Lens Educators and the American Association of Optometric Educators. For the past twenty years Patrick has served as a contributing editor for the Contact Lens Spectrum and is on the editorial board for Contact Lens and Anterior Eye and Eye and Contact Lens Journals. He has published over 300 papers on a wide range of contact lens topics and has lectured extensively throughout the world.

Thomas G. Quinn, O.D., M.S., F.A.A.O. is in group practice in Athens, Ohio. He has served as chair of the American Optometric Association's Contact Lens and Cornea Section Council; he is a diplomate of the Cornea, Contact Lens and Refractive Technologies Section of the American Academy of Optometry; an advisor to the Gas Permeable Lens Institute (GPLI); chair of the EastWest Eye Conference; and a co-administrator for Vision Source with his wife, Dr. Susan Quinn. In addition to private practice, Dr. Quinn serves as Associate Professor of Clinical Practice for The Ohio State University College of Optometry and Clinical Assistant Professor for The Ohio University College of Medicine.

Roy Wesley, OD, PhD, is a Chicago based optometrist who graduated from the New England College of Optometry. He received his PhD from City University of New York in Cell and Molecular Biology and worked for Pfizer Labs in New Jersey, New York and Connecticut. Dr. Wesley practiced low vision clinical research using orthokeratology and other techniques at the Eye Clinic of the National Eye Research Foundation (NERF). Dr. Wesley is a former president of NERF and is currently an officer of the Fund of the Dr. Newton K. Wesley Foundation which sponsors innovative research projects in contact lenses and orthokeratology. Dr. Wesley is currently writing a biography of his father, Dr. Newton K. Wesley, the co-founder of Wesley-Jessen, Inc. (The Plastic Contact Lens Company) titled "Invisible Vision" and is also working on a personal memoir. 2017 celebrates the 100th anniversary of the birth of Dr. Newton K. Wesley.
