Jordan Keith, OD, FAAO

Dr. Jordan Keith is a graduate of Pacific University College of Optometry and completed a hospital-based residency in ocular disease at the Kansas City VA Medical Center. Following residency, Dr. Keith joined the full-time faculty at the Illinois College of Optometry. His passion for education was acknowledged by receiving six teaching awards while at ICO. After five years at ICO, Dr. Keith joined the Eye Care Center, a group optometry private practice in Minneapolis/St. Paul, MN.

In addition, Dr. Keith is an active instructor on the KMK Educational Services team, a company that teaches review courses to optometry students preparing for their NBEO national boards and to optometrists preparing to take the ABO board certification examination. He also teaches CE to optometrists at regional and national meetings.



Nathan Lighthizer, OD, FAAO

Dr. Nathan Lighthizer, O.D., F.A.A.O., is a graduate of Pacific University College of Optometry. Upon graduation, he completed a residency in Family Practice Optometry with an emphasis in Ocular Disease through Northeastern State University Oklahoma College of Optometry.
