Driving Directions

Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences (MCPHS) School of Optometry Lincoln Square Academic & Student Center 10 Lincoln Square Worcester, MA 01608

From the North or South: Take 495 to Exit 25B for I-290 W toward Worcester. On 290, take Exit 18 for Rte 9 to Ware/Framingham. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Downtown and merge onto Lincoln Street. Cross Rte 9 (Belmont Street); Lincoln Street becomes Major Taylor Blvd. MCPHS is about 500 feet on the right. Parking directions are below.

From the West: Take the Mass Pike (1-90) East to Exit 10 (Rte 290 East/Worcester). On 290, take Exit 17 for Rte 9 to Ware/Framingham. Turn left onto Rte 9 West (Belmont Street). Turn left onto Major Taylor Blvd. MCPHS is about 500 feet on the right. Parking directions are below.

Parking: Once you have taken the right from Major Taylor Blvd, the parking garage is on the right, directly across from MCPHS.
