MEET THE SPEAKERS



Dr. Marie I. Bodack, OD, FAAO earned her Doctor of Optometry degree from The State University of New York State College of Optometry and completed a residency in Pediatrics and Binocular Vision at the Pennsylvania College of Optometry. She is a Fellow of the American Academy of Optometry and a Diplomate in its Binocular Vision, Perception and Pediatric Optometry Section. Dr. Bodack has lectured nationally and internationally on a variety of pediatric topics. Dr. Bodack served as a faculty member at the State University of New York State College of Optometry in the Pediatrics, Adult Primary Care and Vision Therapy Departments while working in a private practice, was on staff at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center Department of Ophthalmology, and had a faculty appointment through the University of Cincinnati, Department of Ophthalmology. Dr. Bodack is currently the Chief of the Pediatric Primary Care Department at Southern College of Optometry.



Dr. Ian Ben Gaddie, OD, FAAO earned his Doctor of Optometry from the University of Alabama-Birmingham School of Optometry. Dr. Gaddie then completed a Residency in Ocular Disease through Northeastern State University College of Optometry at the Triad Eye Medical Clinic and Cataract Institute in Tulsa, OK. Dr. Gaddie completed both his Residency and also a Fellowship in Glaucoma and Laser Therapy at NSU College of Optometry. Currently he is the owner and director of the Gaddie Eye Centers, a multi-location full service practice in Louisville that was started by his father over 40 years ago. He is a Fellow of the American Academy of Optometry and President of the Optometric Glaucoma Society. Dr. Gaddie is currently the chair of the Continuing Education Committee for the American Optometric Association and is also the Immediate Past President of the Kentucky Optometric Association. Dr. Gaddie serves on the editorial boards of Review of Optometry, Optometric Management, Primary Care Optometry News and Optometry Times. In 2011, Dr. Gaddie was inducted into the Oklahoma Pioneers in Optometry Hall of Fame.



Dr. Scot Morris, OD is an International speaker, educator, author, and management consultant who is well known for his experience in ocular surface disease, technology, and practice management. He is recognized for both his expertise and his enthusiasm in helping professionals optimize their practices. Dr. Morris is widely published in professional journals, books, clinical references, and web-based resources. He also serves as the Chief Optometric Editor for Optometric Management and as a consultant to a number of successful eye care companies. Dr. Morris is the operating partner of the eye care consulting service, Morris Education & Consulting Associates, is the founder and senior technology consultant of Ocular Technology Solutions, Inc., and also serves as owner and medical director of Eye Consultants of Colorado. Dr. Morris is one of the founding members of the National Student Practice Management Symposium Series and a member of both American Optometric Association and the Colorado Optometric Association.



Dr. Sunny M. Sanders, OD, FAAO obtained her Doctor of Optometry degree from the Illinois College of Optometry. She completed a Post-Doctoral Residency in Cornea and Contact Lenses at the Illinois College of Optometry. Dr. Sanders has held full-time faculty positions at the Illinois College of Optometry, Southern California College of Optometry, and Arizona College of Optometry where she served in numerous teaching and administrative roles. Dr. Sanders owned and operated two optometric practices. She lectures nationally in the areas of Ocular Prosthetics, Practice Management, Contact Lenses, and Ocular Nutrition, is a Fellow of the American Academy of Optometry, Co-Author of an optometry textbook, and is Co-Editor of an optometry coding book. Dr. Sanders currently serves as the Founding Dean at the Midwestern University College of Optometry- Illinois.



Dr. Diana Shechtman, OD, FAAO is a professor of optometry at Nova Southeastern University College of Optometry, where she serves as an attending optometric physician at the eye institute and diabetic/macula clinic. Dr. Shechtman is a fellow of the American Academy of Optometry, as well as the Optometric Retinal Society and Ocular Nutrition Society. Her area of interest has centered on retinal disease. She has participated in various research projects, authored numerous posters and publications. She is also a member of the editorial board for a number of journals. She has lectured on a local, national and international level on areas in retinal disease.
