NGS Conference Cancellation Policy

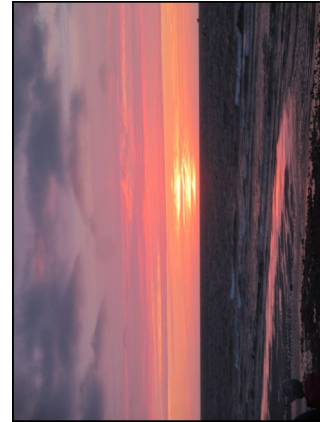

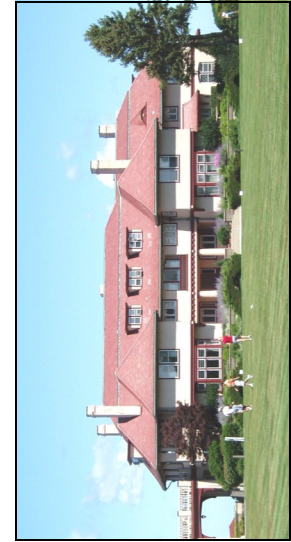
